

CHURCH OF ENGLAND (NORFOLK ISLAND) BILL, 1981

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The Church of England Trust Property (Amendment) Bill, 1981, is cognate with this Bill.

The object of this Bill is to provide for an Act affecting the Church of England complementary to the Act of the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island enacted as a consequence of the inclusion of Norfolk Island in the Diocese of Sydney.

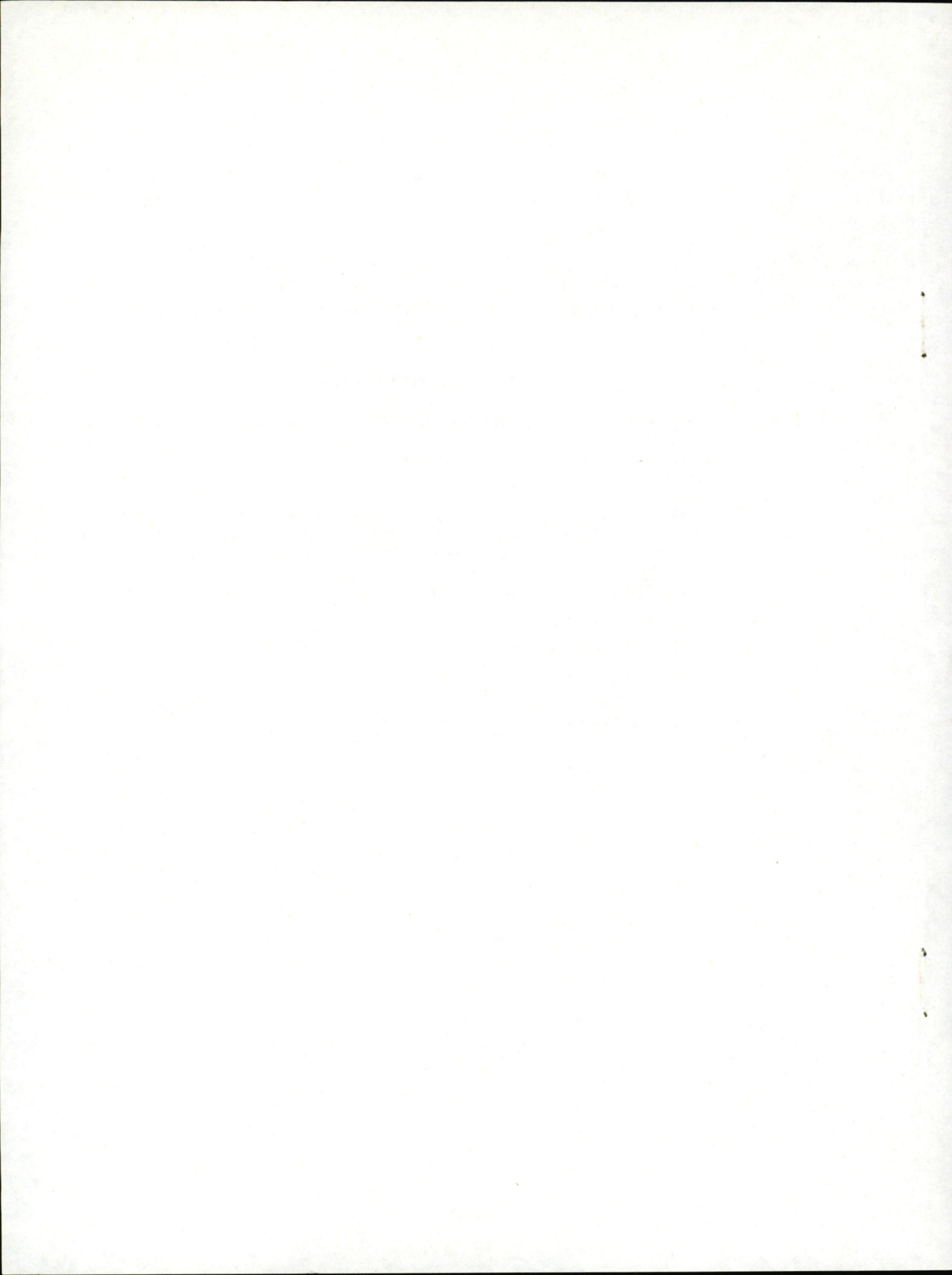
The Bill contains the following provisions:—

Clause 2. Commencement.

Clause 3. Principal Acts.

Clause 4 provides for the operation of the Principal Acts as a consequence of the inclusion of Norfolk Island in the Diocese of Sydney.

Church of England (Norfolk Island).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

⁵ **Short title.**

1. This Act may be cited as the "Church of England (Norfolk Island) Act, 1981".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent
10 to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

Principal Acts.

¹⁵ **3.** In this Act—

- (a) the Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902;
- (b) the Church of England in Australia Constitution Act, 1961; and
- (c) section 17 of the Interpretation Act, 1897, in its application to those Acts,

²⁰ are referred to as the Principal Acts.

Application of Principal Acts.

4. The Principal Acts have effect as if Norfolk Island formed part of New South Wales.

Church of England (Norfolk Island).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Church of England (Norfolk Island) Act, 1981".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

Principal Acts.

3. In this Act—

- (a) the Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902;
- (b) the Church of England in Australia Constitution Act, 1961; and
- (c) section 17 of the Interpretation Act, 1897, in its application to those Acts,

are referred to as the Principal Acts.

Application of Principal Acts.

4. The Principal Acts have effect as if Norfolk Island formed part of New South Wales.
