BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

Short title.

This Act may be cited as the "Coal Mines Regulation 1. (Coroners) Amendment Act. 1980".

Commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Coroners Bill, 1980.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to repeal section 66 of the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1912, which deals with the procedure at inquests concerning the deaths of persons which have been caused by explosions or accidents in or about mines, as that procedure is dealt with in provisions contained in the proposed Coroners Act, 1980; and
- (b) to make other provisions of a minor character.
