Consumer Protection (Legal Services Commission) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Protection (Legal Services Commission) Amendment Act, 1979".

Commencement.

- **2.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Section 3 shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (3) of the Legal Services Commission Act, 1979.

Amendment of Act No. 28, 1969.

Sec. 16I.

(Assignment of cases of assisted persons to solicitors.)

- 3. The Consumer Protection Act, 1969, is amended by omitting section 161 (1) (a) (i) and by inserting instead the following subparagraph:—
 - (i) the Public Solicitor or any other solicitor who is an officer
 of the Legal Services Commission of New South Wales,
 but only if that Commission has agreed to the case being
 so assigned;
