*Co-operation (Fisheries and Oyster Farms) Amendment.*

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Co-operation (Fisheries and Oyster Farms) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

**2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

10 (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day on which Schedule 4 (37) to the Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Amendment) Act, 1979, commences.

**3.** The Co-operation Act, 1923, is amended by omitting section 10A and by inserting instead the following section :— Amendment of Act No. 1, 1924. Sec. 10A.

15 **10A.** A trading society shall not establish, control or operate a market for the sale of fish except in accordance with the provisions of the Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act, 1935. Trading society—fish market.
