EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Anti-Discrimination (Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to provide a defence of absolute privilege in proceedings for defamation in respect of certain publications to or by the Director of Equal Opportunity in Public Employment appointed under the Anti-Discrimination Act, 1977, as amended by the proposed Anti-Discrimination (Amendment) Act, 1980.
