District Court (Frustrated Contracts) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "District Court (Frustrated Contracts) Amendment Act, 1978".

Commence- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Frustrated Contracts Act, 1978.


EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Frustrated Contracts Bill, 1978.

The object of this Bill is to confer jurisdiction on the District Court to hear and determine an application under Division 4 of Part III of the Frustrated Contracts Act, 1978 (adjustment by the court of rights and liabilities following frustration of a contract) where the value of the claim does not exceed \$20,000.
