An Act to amend the Farm Water Storages and Bores Subsidies Act, 1973, to enable the prescribed authority within the meaning of that Act to approve certain applications for subsidies toward the cost of works commenced before the applications were made. [Assented to, 26th May. 1981.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Farm Water Storages and Bores Subsidies (Amendment) Act, 1981".
