Firearms and Dangerous Weapons (Pawnbrokers) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Firearms and Dangerous Weapons (Pawnbrokers) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commence- **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Pawnbrokers (Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend the definition of "firearms dealer" in section 6 (1) of the Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Act, 1973, to ensure that the provisions of that Act which apply to and in respect of firearms dealers apply to and in respect of pawnbrokers who take firearms in pawn.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the Bill is to amend the definition of "firearms dealer" in section 5 (1) of the Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Act, 1977, to ensure that the provisions of that Act which apply to and in respect of firearms dealers apply to and in respect of paymibrokers who take firearms in pawn.
