#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Courts of Petty Sessions (Civil Claims) Amendment Bill, 1980.

The objects of this Bill are-

- (a) to omit from the Frustrated Contracts Act, 1978, provisions relating to the removal of certain actions commenced in courts of petty sessions into the District Court (clause 3); and
- (b) to make other provisions of a minor or ancillary character.

Short title.
