Act No. 46, 1981.

An Act to amend section 56J of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, in relation to the Greyhound Racing Control Board Fund. [Assented to, 15th May, 1981.]

Gaming and Betting (Greyhound Racing Control Board) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting (Greyhound Racing Control Board) Amendment Act, 1981".

Amendment of Act No. 25, 1912.

2. The Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, is amended by inserting in section 56J (2) after the word "Part" the words "or under the Totalizator Act, 1916, the Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, or any other Act".

GAMING AND BETTING (GREYHOUND RACING CONTROL BOARD) AMENDMENT BILL, 1981

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Amendment Bill, 1981.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, to provide that money received by the Greyhound Racing Control Board under the Totalizator Act, 1916, the Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, or any other Act shall be paid into the Greyhound Racing Control Board Fund.

BOARD AMENDMENT BILL 1981
GIVING ADDITIONAL POWERS TO THE BOARD

EXPLANATORY NOTES

(The explanatory notes are set out in the following pages.)

The Bill is designed to give the Board (the Board of Directors) additional powers to enable it to carry out its duties more effectively. The Bill is divided into three parts. Part I contains provisions relating to the Board's powers to appoint and dismiss directors and to fill casual vacancies. Part II contains provisions relating to the Board's powers to appoint and dismiss officers and employees. Part III contains provisions relating to the Board's powers to appoint and dismiss members of committees and sub-committees. The Bill also contains provisions relating to the Board's powers to appoint and dismiss members of advisory committees and sub-committees. The Bill is intended to be a permanent law.
