EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to reduce by one-quarter the rates of additional supplementary license tax payable by clubs in respect of the keeping, use and operation of poker machines in respect of the period of 12 months ending 31st May, 1979, and any subsequent period of 12 months; and**
 - (b) to make other provisions of an ancillary or consequential character.**

THEORY OF THE ATOM

1. The Bohr model of the atom. The electron orbits the nucleus in discrete orbits. The energy levels are quantized. The energy of the electron in the n th orbit is given by $E_n = -\frac{13.6 \text{ eV}}{n^2}$. The energy difference between two orbits is $\Delta E = E_f - E_i = 13.6 \text{ eV} \left(\frac{1}{i^2} - \frac{1}{f^2} \right)$. The wavelength of the emitted photon is $\lambda = \frac{hc}{\Delta E}$.

2. The Balmer series. The Balmer series consists of the visible spectral lines of hydrogen. The Balmer formula is $\frac{1}{\lambda} = R_H \left(\frac{1}{2^2} - \frac{1}{n^2} \right)$, where R_H is the Rydberg constant for hydrogen, $R_H = 1.097 \times 10^7 \text{ m}^{-1}$.

3. The Lyman series. The Lyman series consists of the ultraviolet spectral lines of hydrogen. The Lyman formula is $\frac{1}{\lambda} = R_H \left(\frac{1}{1^2} - \frac{1}{n^2} \right)$.

4. The Paschen series. The Paschen series consists of the infrared spectral lines of hydrogen. The Paschen formula is $\frac{1}{\lambda} = R_H \left(\frac{1}{3^2} - \frac{1}{n^2} \right)$.

5. The Brackett series. The Brackett series consists of the infrared spectral lines of hydrogen. The Brackett formula is $\frac{1}{\lambda} = R_H \left(\frac{1}{4^2} - \frac{1}{n^2} \right)$.

6. The Pfund series. The Pfund series consists of the infrared spectral lines of hydrogen. The Pfund formula is $\frac{1}{\lambda} = R_H \left(\frac{1}{5^2} - \frac{1}{n^2} \right)$.

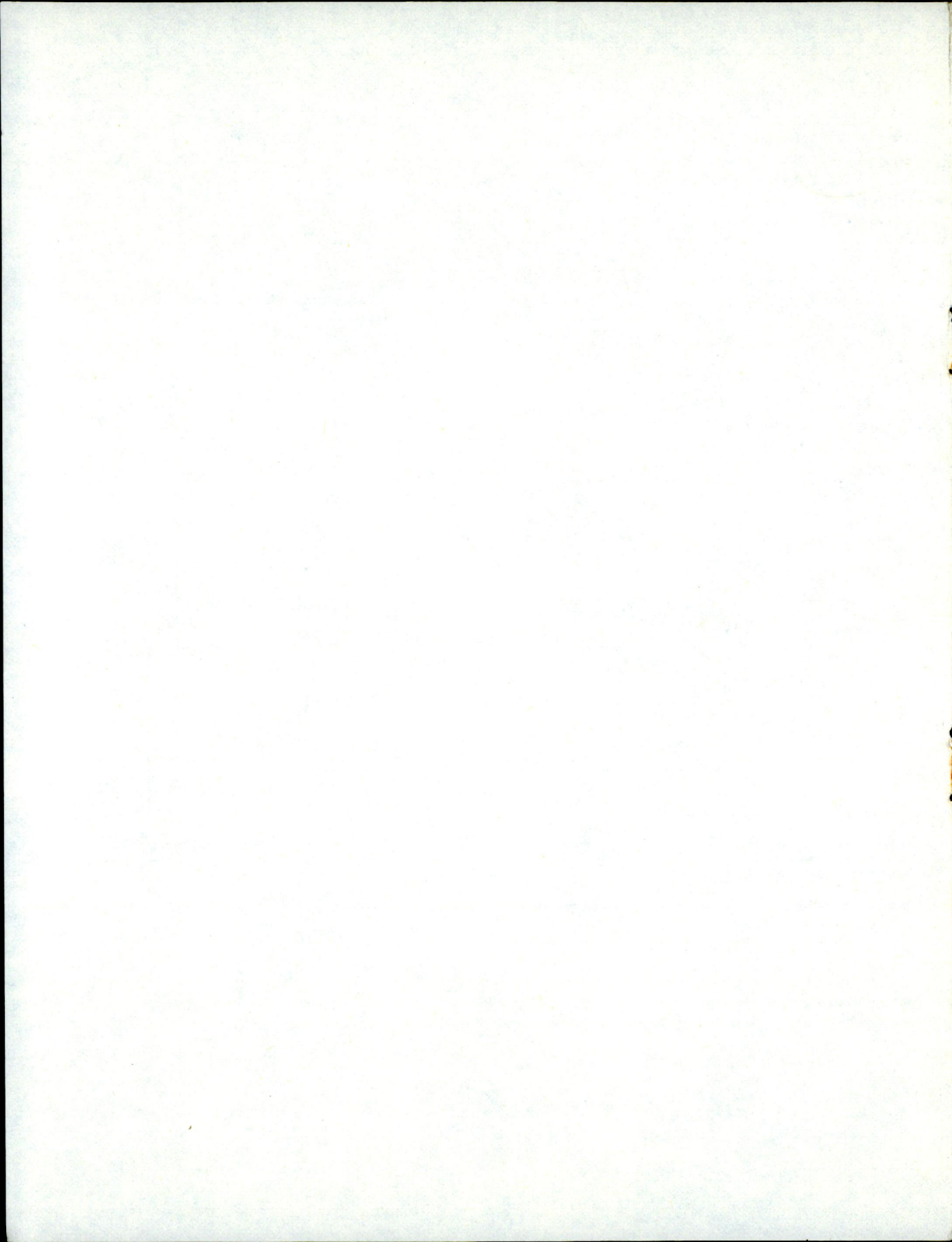
