**An Act to amend section 53 of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912,

Gaming and Betting (Race-meetings) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting (Race-meetings) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

2. (1) This Act, other than section 3, shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commence-
ment.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

3. The Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, is amended—

15 (1) Meetings for horse-racing at race-courses situated within 64 kilometres of the General Post Office, Sydney, may, subject to this Act, be held only—

Gaming and Betting (Race-meetings) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting (Race-meetings) Amendment Act, 1979".

Commence-ment. **2.** (1) This Act, other than section 3, shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

3. The Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, is amended—
