

**GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS (CONSTITUTION)
AMENDMENT BILL, 1979**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Constitution (Legislative Council Compensation) Bill, 1979.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable members of the Legislative Council to retain their free railway passes until they cease to be entitled to parliamentary remuneration instead of until they cease to be members in order that a member whose term of office has expired may retain his pass pending the outcome of the ensuing general election (clause 2 (a)); and
 - (b) to delete a provision, relating to free railway passes to certain former members of the Legislative Council, by way of statute law revision (clause 2 (b)).
