EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Growth Centres) Amendment Bill, 1979, is cognate with this Bill.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to change the office of Chairman of a corporation constituted under the Growth Centres (Development Corporations) Act, 1974, from a full-time to a part-time position;
 - (b) to change the office of Deputy Chairman of a corporation constituted under that Act to that of General Manager; and
 - (c) to make other amendments of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.

Growth Centres (Development Corporations) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

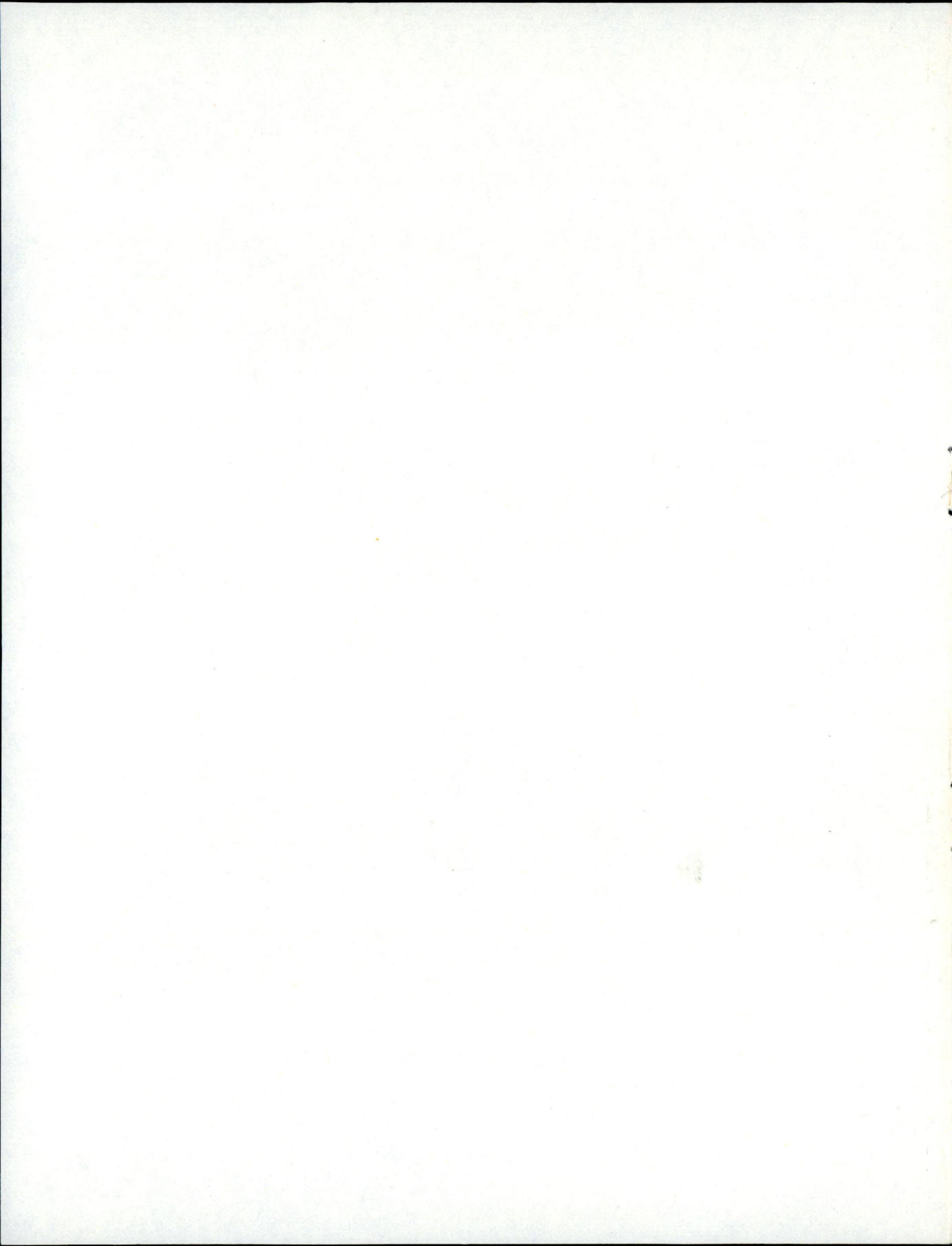
