EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Consumer Credit Bill, 1981.

The object of this Bill is to repeal the Hire-Purchase Act, 1960, as a consequence of the enactment of section 14 of the proposed Consumer Credit Act, 1981, under which a hire-purchase agreement with a person other than a corporation will have effect as a sale under which the property in the goods to which the agreement relates will pass, subject to the cash price of the goods not exceeding \$15,000 or the goods being a commercial motor vehicle or farm machinery.

The Bill continues the operation of the repealed Act in relation to transactions entered into before its repeal.
