Act No. 143, 1980.

An Act to amend section 104A of the Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1938, to extend the class of persons eligible for rating concessions. [Assented to, 10th December, 1980.] Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage (Rating) Amendment.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage (Rating) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Section 3 and Schedule 1 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July, 1979.

Amendment of Act No. 11, 1938. **3.** The Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1938, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

Refund of certain rates, etc.

- **4.** (1) In this section, a reference to a provision of section 104A is a reference to a provision of section 104A of the Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1938, as amended by this Act.
- (2) Where, in respect of a rate levied by the Hunter District Water Board for the year commencing on 1st July, 1979, or 1st July, 1980—
  - (a) an application is made to the Board under section 104A(3) or (5) by a person entitled to make the application; and
  - (b) the person has, before the date on which the application is made, paid, in whole or in part, the rate or a rating contribution in respect of the rate,

the Board shall refund to the person the amount by which the rate is required to be reduced under section 104A (3) or (5) to the extent, if any, to which the rate or rating contribution has been overpaid.
