
INTOXICATED PERSONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to extend the operation of the Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979 ("the Act"), so that it applies to persons under the age of 18 years as well as to persons of or above that age;
- (b) to enable certain authorised persons to perform certain functions on behalf of persons in charge of proclaimed places under the Act; and
- (c) to make other amendments of a minor or ancillary character.

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979, with respect to persons under the age of 18 years.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the "Intoxicated Persons Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1980".
 - 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date Commence of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall 10 commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979.
 - 3. The Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979, is amended in the Amendment of Act No. 67, 1979.

(2) A place or a class of places may, under a proclamation made for the purposes of paragraph (a) or (b) of the definition of "proclaimed place" in subsection (1), be declared to be a proclaimed place or a class of proclaimed places, as the case may be, for both adults and juveniles.





Act No. 1, 1980.

An Act to amend the Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979, with respect to persons under the age of 18 years. [Assented to, 6th March, 1980.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Intoxicated Persons (Amendment) Act, 1980".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979.

Amendment of Act No. 67, 1979.

3. The Intoxicated Persons Act, 1979, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.
