### EXPLANATORY NOTE

## (This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Public Transport Commission (Loans) Amendment Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Land Commission Act, 1976, so as to enable the Land Commission of New South Wales to obtain, with the approval of the Governor-in-Council, temporary financial accommodation, including accommodation involving the issue by the Commission of bills of exchange or promissory notes. The Governor-in-Council may approve of the due repayment of any money so obtained being guaranteed by the Government.
