This Bill is cognate with the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Bill, 1979.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to remove from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Act, 1961, the power of the Governor to make regulations with respect to the control and licensing of persons to carry out certain work on pipes, equipment or apparatus used for the conveyance or consumption of liquefied petroleum gas other than in internal combustion engines; and
 - (b) to prohibit the carrying out of certain work in connection with pipes, equipment or apparatus used for the conveyance or consumption of liquefied petroleum gas other than in internal combustion engines.

Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment Act, 1979”. Short title.

2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

- 20 (i) is the holder of a licence or certificate of registration granted under the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Act, 1979, in relation to which liquefied petroleum gasfitting work of that class or description is authorised work within the meaning of that Act; or
- 25 (ii) does so under the immediate supervision of the holder of such a licence.

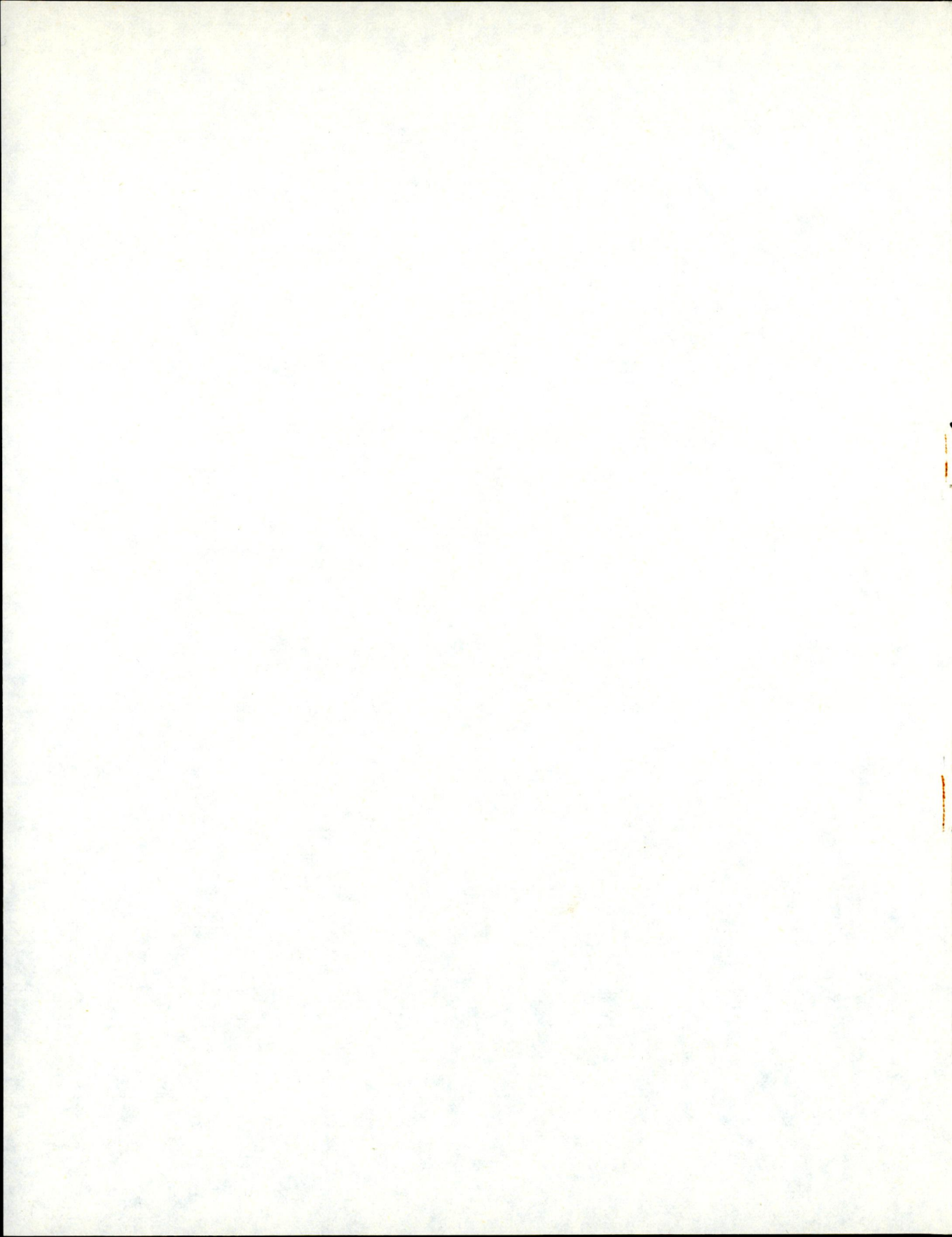
