Act No. 97, 1980.

An Act to amend section 168 of the Liquor Act, 1912, to provide for the issue by the licensing court of licenses under that Act for the sale of liquor on premises vested in the Historic Houses Trust of New South Wales. [Assented to, 1st May, 1980.]

Liquor (Historic Houses) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Liquor (Historic Houses) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Historic Houses Act, 1980.

Amendment of Act No. 42, 1912.
Sec. 168 (7). (Historic houses.)

3. The Liquor Act, 1912, is amended by omitting from section 168 (7) the words "Elizabeth Bay House" wherever occurring and by inserting instead the words "premises vested in the Historic Houses Trust of New South Wales".

License to continue in force. 4. Where, immediately before the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Historic Houses Act, 1980, a license was in force under section 168 (7) of the Liquor Act, 1912, as enacted immediately before that day, the license continues in force on and after that day as if it had been issued under section 168 (7) of the Liquor Act, 1912, as amended by this Act.

LIQUOR (HISTORIC HOUSES) AMENDMENT BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Historic Houses Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to authorise the licensing court to issue licenses for the sale of liquor on premises vested in the Historic Houses Trust of New South Wales.

The Bill contains the following provisions:—

Clause 1. Short title.

Clause 2. Commencement.

Clause 3. Amendment of the Liquor Act, 1912.

Clause 4. Transitional provision continuing in force any liquor license pertaining to Elizabeth Bay House.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
