



LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MOTOR TRAFFIC) AMENDMENT BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to amend the Local Government Act, 1919 ("the Principal Act"), to provide that any person who, pursuant to a regulation under the Motor Traffic Act, 1909, is to be treated as being the owner of a motor vehicle for the purposes of section 18A of the Motor Traffic Act, 1909, shall be deemed to be an owner of the vehicle for the purposes of sections 2700, 270R and 351B of the Principal Act (liability for parking offences) (Schedule 1); and
- (b) to amend Divisions 13A and 13B of Part IX of the Principal Act by way of statute law revision (Schedule 2).

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2. The Local Government Act, 1919, is referred to in this Principal Act, as the Principal Act.
