EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Bill, 1979.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to remove from the Local Government Act, 1919, the power of the Governor to make ordinances for the control and licensing of persons to carry out plumbing and drainage work; and
 - (b) to prohibit the carrying out of certain plumbing or drainage work except by persons who are the holders of licences or certificates of registration granted under the proposed Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Act, 1979, in relation to that work or who do so under the immediate supervision of the holder of a licence of a class prescribed in relation to that work.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MEMBERS' PRIVILEGES AND

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to the Bill as introduced in Parliament.)

The Bill is concerned with the Members' Dues and Expenses Bill, 1978.

The object of the Bill is—

- (a) to remove from the Local Government Act, 1976, the power of the Government to make regulations for the control and discipline of persons to carry out planning and drainage work; and
- (b) to prohibit the carrying out of certain planning or drainage work except by persons who are the holders of licences or certificates of registration granted under the proposed Members' Dues and Expenses Bill, 1978, in relation to that work or who do so under the licence or certificate of the holder of a licence or certificate in relation to that work.

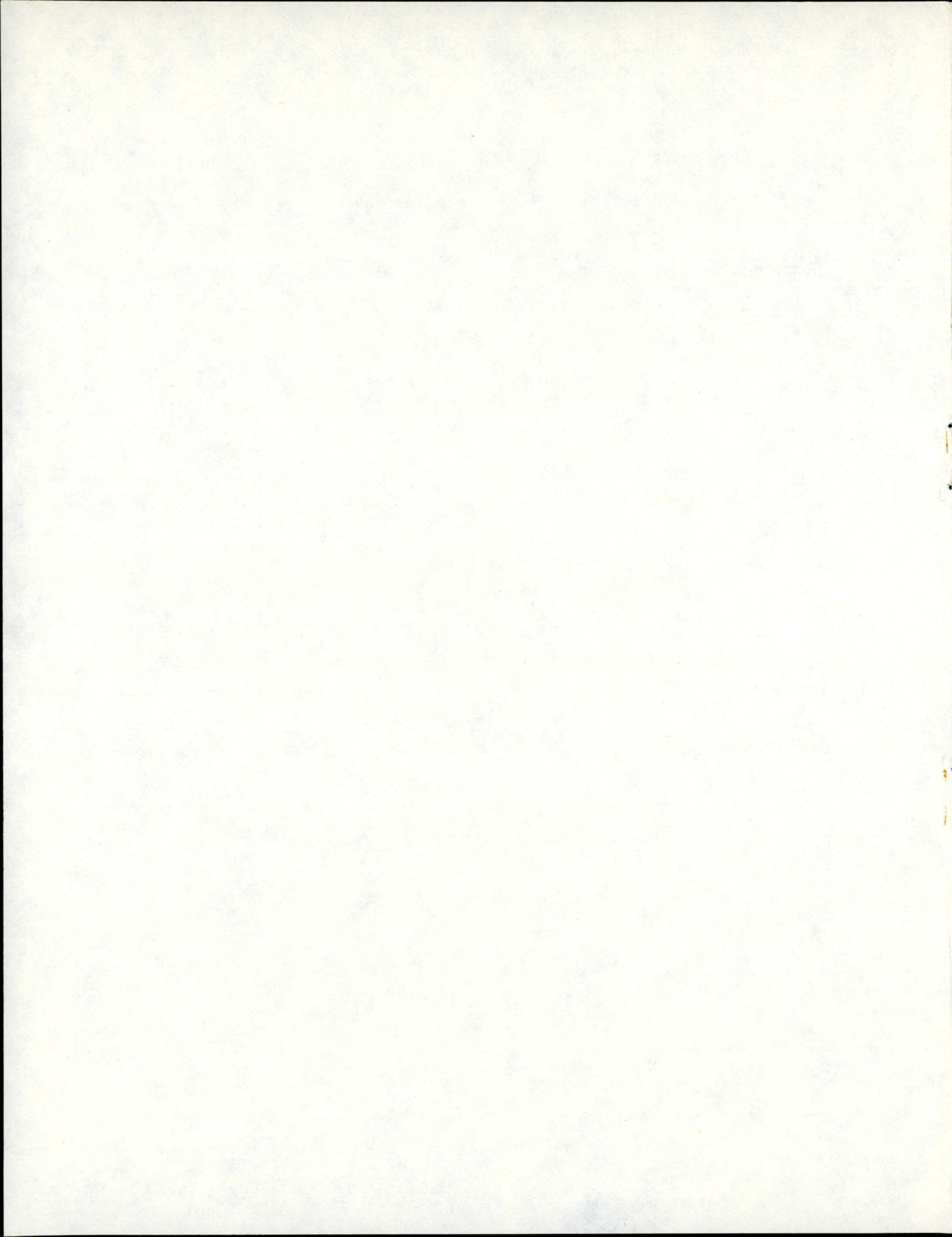
