Act No. 147, 1980.

An Act to amend the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901, to provide for the substitution of prizes by art unions and similar associations and to increase the penalties which may be imposed under that Act. [Assented to, 10th December, 1980.]

Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short
title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment) Act, 1980".

Commence-
ment.

2. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 5 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedule 1 or 2, commence on the day on which that provision commences.

(3) Schedule 1 shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

3. The Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901, is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

(2) An amendment made to a provision of the Principal Act by section 5 and Schedule 2 does not affect any penalty which may be imposed in respect of an offence committed against that provision before the commencement of that amendment.

“prize”, in relation to an art union, means whatever was, when the art union was first deemed to be a lawful association under section 5 (1), proposed to be allotted or distributed by the art union by chance or otherwise among the several members, subscribers or contributors forming part of the art union.

(2) Subject to subsections (4) and (5), the Minister may approve of the substitution by an art union of a prize if he is satisfied that the prize has been lost or destroyed or for any other reason cannot be allotted or distributed by the art union.

(3) An application for the Minister's approval under subsection (2) shall be made in writing to the Minister.

(4) Where a prize is a major prize, the Minister shall not approve of the substitution by an art union of that prize unless—

(a) he is satisfied that subscribers or contributors to the art union have been given adequate opportunity to withdraw from membership of the art union; and

(b) he is satisfied that any regulations made under this Act relating to the substitution of prizes and the refund of subscriptions or contributions have been complied with.

(5) Whatever is proposed to be substituted for a prize pursuant to this section must be, in the opinion of the Minister, substantially similar to, and not less in value than, that prize.

(6) Whatever is approved by the Minister under this section to be substituted for a prize shall be deemed to be, and always to have been, that prize.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to provide for the substitution, in certain circumstances, of prizes proposed to be given by art unions and similar associations (Schedule 1); and
 - (b) to increase the penalties which may be imposed under the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901 (Schedule 2).

LOTTERIES AND ART UNIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1950

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to the Bill as introduced into Parliament.)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to provide for the amendment of section 1 of the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1947, in relation to the prizes payable in lotteries and art unions and similar institutions; and
- (b) to increase the penalties which may be imposed under the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1947, in relation to 21.

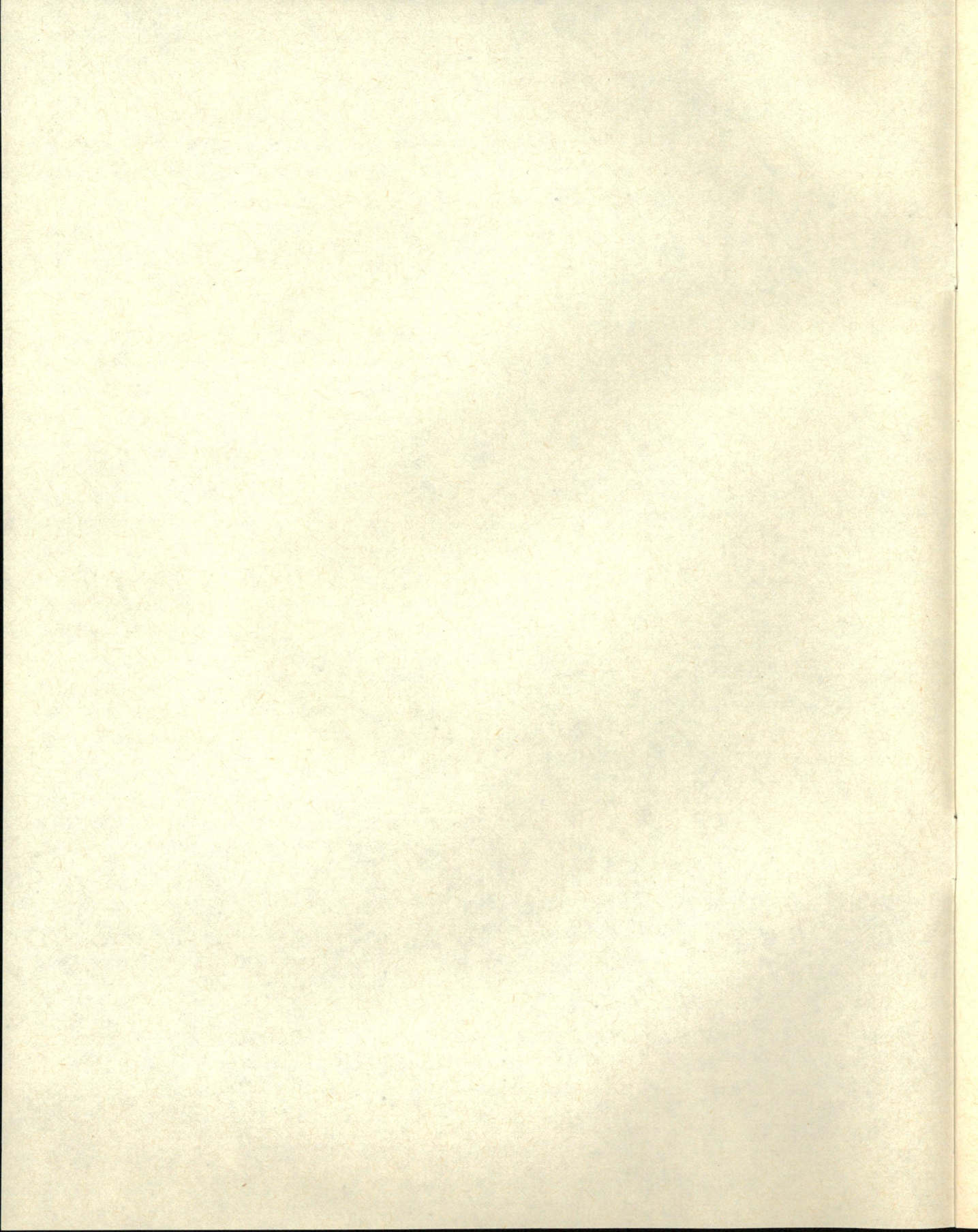
