
(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the University of Newcastle (Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to substitute section 22 (1) of the Macquarie University Act, 1964 ("the Principal Act"), to enable the Council of the Macquarie University ("the University") to delegate certain of its powers and functions to any member of the Council of the University ("the Council"), to the Academic Senate of the University ("the Academic Senate"), to any committee of the Council or Academic Senate or to any officer or officers of the University (Schedule 1 (2));
- (b) to amend section 23 (1) of the Principal Act to enable the Council to constitute a body to be called the Academic Senate, to constitute committees of the Council or Academic Senate and to regulate meetings thereof (Schedule 1 (3));
- (c) to insert a new section, 23A, in the Principal Act to provide that persons who are not members of the Council may be members of the Academic Senate and that persons who are not members of the Council or Academic Senate may be members of any committee of the Council or Academic Senate respectively (Schedule 1 (4)—proposed section 23A);
- (d) to substitute section 31 (1) of the Principal Act to impose further limitations on the eligibility of certain persons for exemption from fees (Schedule 1 (5));
- (e) to amend the Principal Act by way of statute law revision (Schedule 2); and
- (f) to make other provisions of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.






