An Act to amend section 100A of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, to extend the class of persons eligible for rating concessions. [Assented to, 10th December, 1980.]

Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage (Rating) Amendment.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage (Rating) Amendment Act, 1980".
- Commencement. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 and Schedule 1 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July, 1980.

Amendment **3.** The Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, of Act No. 1924, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

Refund of certain rates, etc. 4. (1) In this section, a reference to a provision of section 100A is a reference to a provision of section 100A of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, as amended by this Act.

(2) Where, in respect of a rate levied by the Metropolitan Water Sewerage and Drainage Board for the year commencing on 1st July, 1980—

- (a) an application is made to the Board under section 100A
  (3) or (5) by a person entitled to make the application; and
- (b) the person has, before the date on which the application is made, paid, in whole or in part, the rate or a rating contribution in respect of the rate,

the Board shall refund to the person the amount by which the rate is required to be reduced under section 100A (3) or (5) to the extent, if any, to which the rate or rating contribution has been overpaid.




#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

#### (This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Local Government (Further Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 100A of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, to extend the class of persons eligible for rating concessions by including persons who are in receipt of a benefit under Part IVAAA of the Commonwealth Social Services Act 1947.
