

**PARLIAMENTARY CONTRIBUTORY SUPERANNUATION  
(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980**

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

The salary of a member of the Legislative Council has been determined on and from 1st January, 1980, at a rate that takes into account the increased workload consequential upon the reduction in the number of members of the Council and the election of members by popular vote. This resulted in a percentage increase considerably in excess of that determined in respect of a member of the Legislative Assembly and it is possible that there may be further adjustments in the relativity of the salaries of the members of each House.

Adjustments based on current salaries of members of Parliament are from time to time made in the superannuation pensions of retired members, and the object of this Bill is to ensure that the pensions of former members of the Legislative Council who retired on or before 6th November, 1978, follow movements in the current salaries of members of the Legislative Assembly rather than those of members of the Legislative Council determined in the light of changed responsibilities incurred after that date.
