

**PARLIAMENTARY CONTRIBUTORY SUPERANNUATION
(CONSTITUTION) AMENDMENT BILL, 1979**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Constitution (Legislative Council Compensation) Bill, 1979.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to amend the Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act, 1971, by way of statute law revision as a consequence of the reconstitution of the Legislative Council (clause 3); and
- (b) to make it clear that certain persons who—
 - (i) ceased to be members of the Legislative Council as a consequence of the reconstitution of that Council; and
 - (ii) were members of the Legislative Council for more than 8 years but less than 15 years,

are entitled to a parliamentary pension (clause 4).

Clause 4 of this Bill gives effect to paragraph 34A (1) of the report of the Parliamentary Remuneration Tribunal tabled in the Legislative Assembly on 8th November, 1978, which the Legislative Assembly resolved to adopt on 16th November, 1978, and the Legislative Council resolved to adopt on 21st November, 1978.
