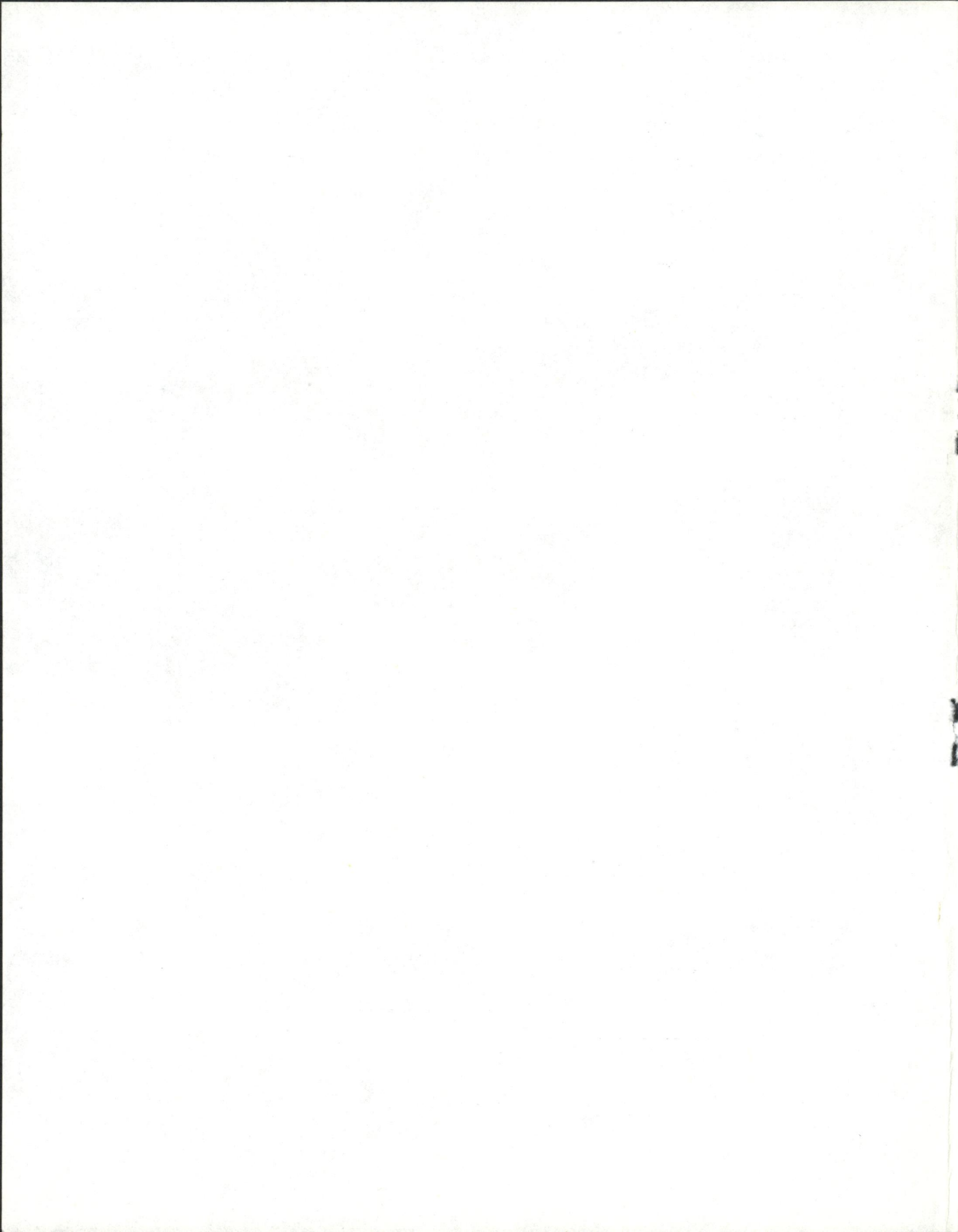

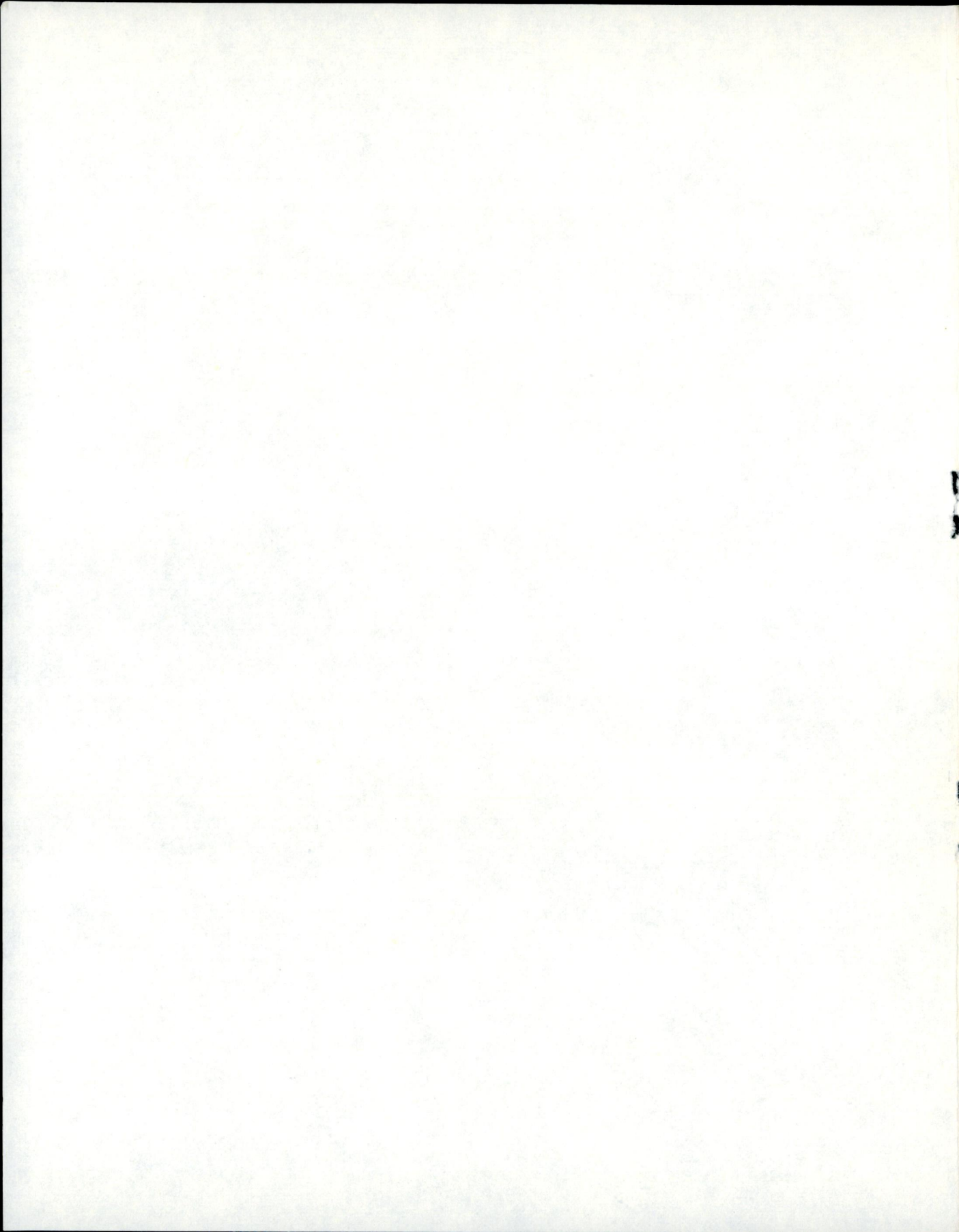

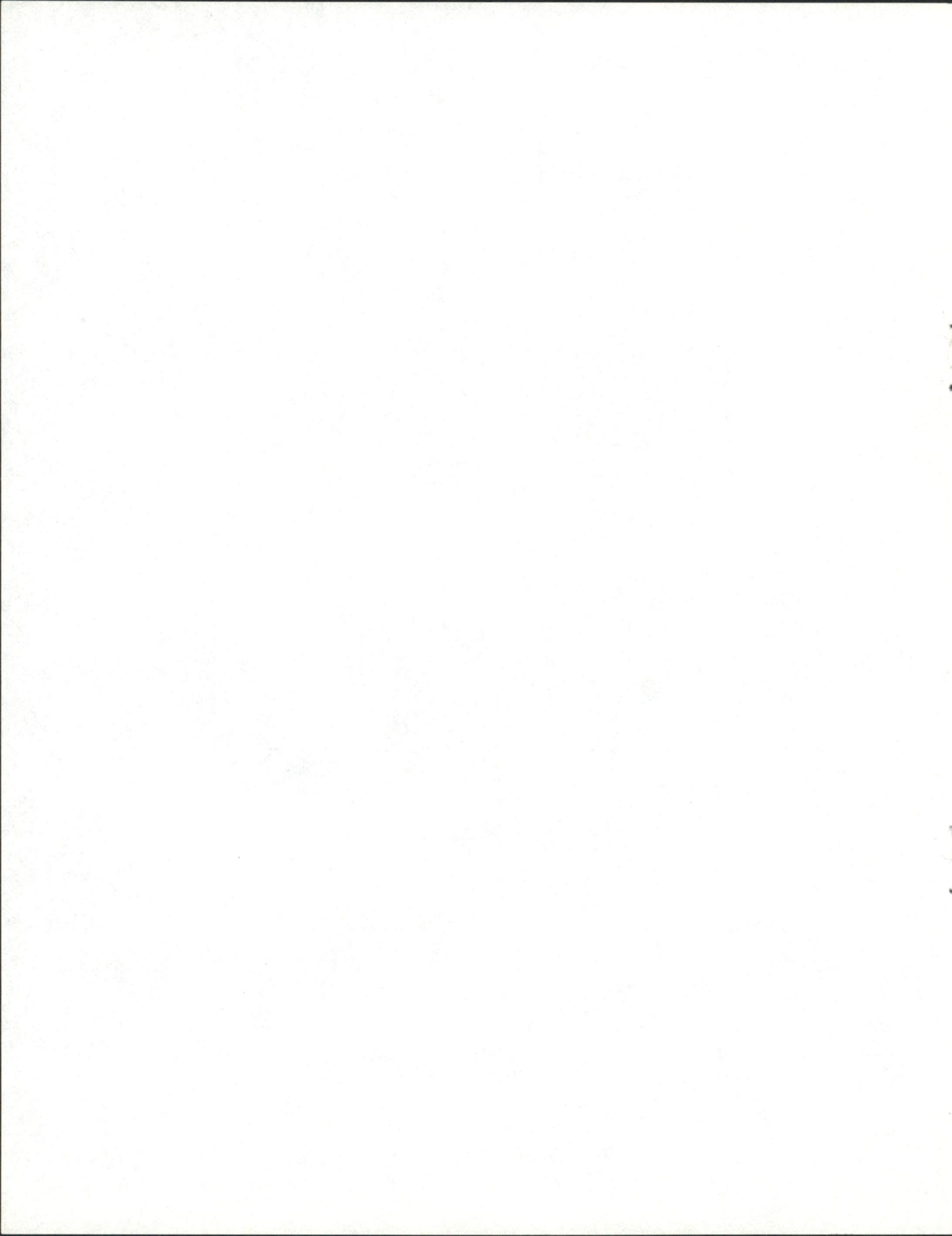

Short title.      **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Pastures Protection (Amendment) Act, 1980".

Amendment of Act No. 35, 1934.      **2.** The Pastures Protection Act, 1934, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

Transitional provision.      **3.** A person who, immediately before the commencement of this Act—

(a) was a director of a pastures protection board under the Pastures Protection Act, 1934; and

(b) held an office of profit under that board,

shall cease to hold office as that director if, at the expiration of 21 days after that commencement, he holds an office of profit under that board.
