An Act to amend section 18A of the Permanent Building Societies Act, 1967, as a consequence of the enactment of the Co-operation (Further Amendment) Act, 1981.

Permanent Building Societies (Co-operation) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Permanent Building Societies (Co-operation) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date 10 of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Co-operation (Further Amendment) Act, 1981.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Permanent Building Societies (Co-operation) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Co-operation (Amendment) Act, 1981.
