

**PHYSIOTHERAPISTS REGISTRATION (CHIROPRACTIC)
AMENDMENT BILL, 1978**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Chiropractic Bill, 1978.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945, for the purpose of excluding from the operation of that Act the practice of a registered chiropractor or osteopath.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

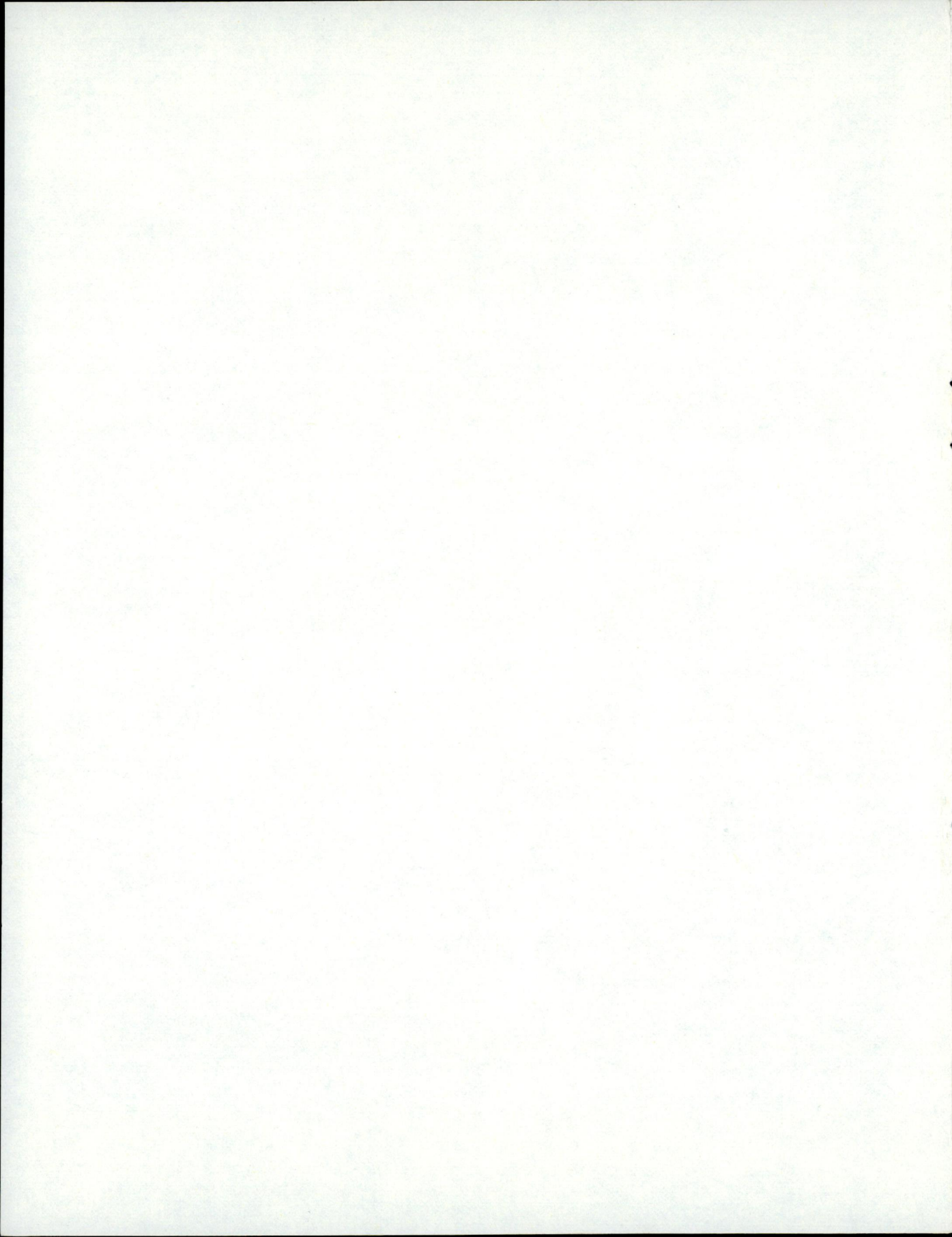

An Act to amend section 26 of the Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945, to exclude from the operation of that Act the practice of a registered chiropractor or osteopath. [Assented to, 21st December, 1978.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Registration (Chiropractic) Amendment Act, 1978".

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Chiropractic Act, 1978.
