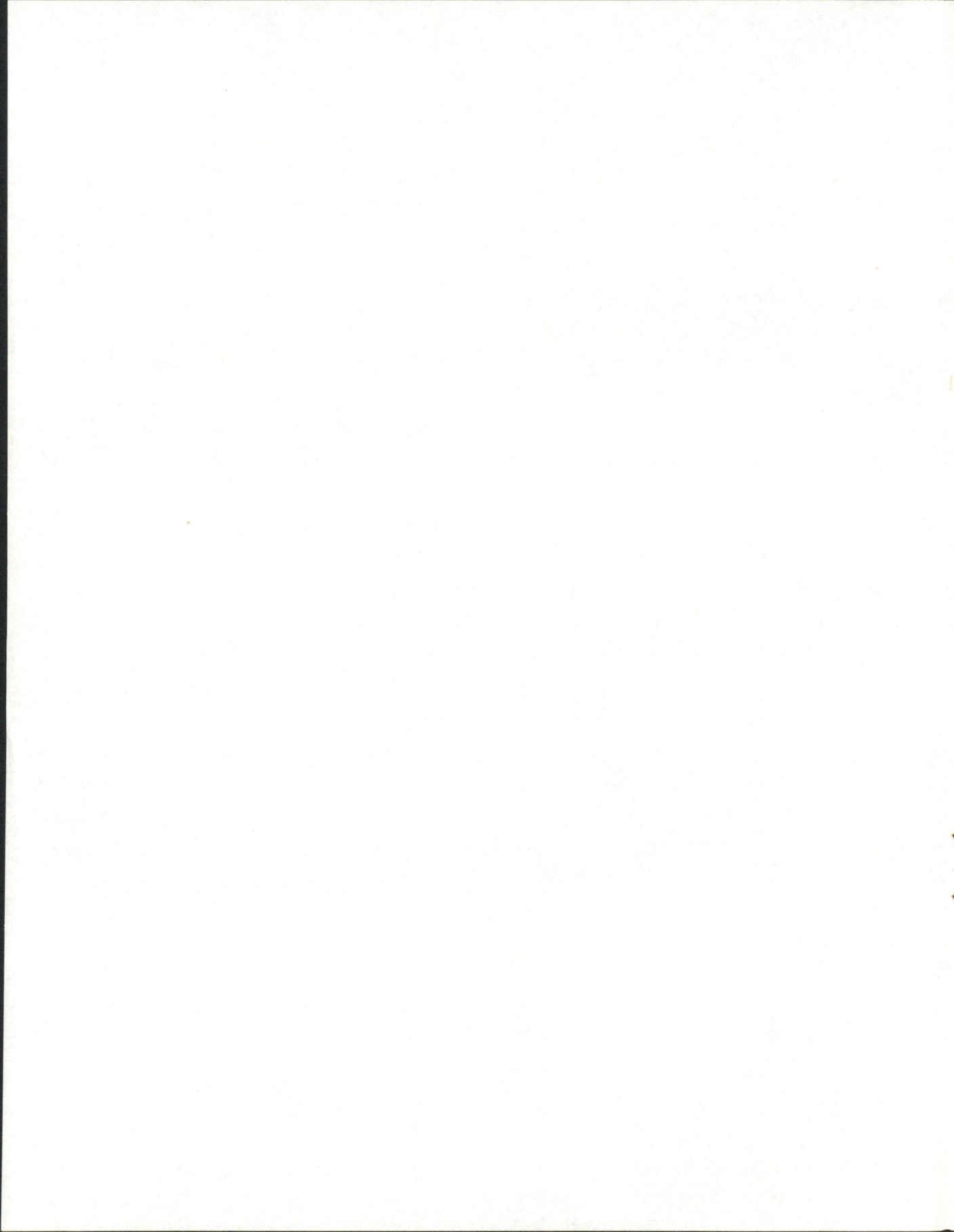

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to increase to \$1,092 the additional annual amount payable with a superannuation allowance granted under the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906 ("the Principal Act"), to the widow of a member of the police force who died before 1st July, 1971, as a result of being hurt on duty;
  - (b) to enable a widow to convert to a lump sum payment the whole or any part of an additional annual amount referred to in paragraph (a);
  - (c) to enable an additional annual amount referred to in paragraph (a) to be adjusted in accordance with movements in the Consumer Price Index;
  - (d) to give effect to the foregoing provisions as from 28th September, 1979;
  - (e) to validate the payment prior to 28th September, 1979, of additional annual amounts of the kind referred to in paragraph (a); and
  - (f) to make other provisions of a minor, ancillary or consequential nature.

(1) The additional annual amount payable with a superannuation allowance granted pursuant to section 12 to the widow of a member of the police force who died before 1st July, 1971, shall, on and from 28th September, 1979, be increased to \$1,092. Increase in additional payments to certain widows.

(2) An additional annual amount referred to in sub-clause (1) shall, for the purposes of this Act, be deemed to be part of the annual superannuation allowance granted pursuant to section 12.

5           3. (1) The liability of the Fund in respect of any additional annual amount referred to in clause 2 may, if the widow to whom it is payable has so elected by notice in writing served on the Board before 1st April, 1980, be redeemed either in whole or in part by the payment from the Fund of a lump sum calculated on the basis of \$250 for each \$26 per annum of the additional annual amount that the widow elects to redeem.

Conversion to lump sum of additional payments to certain widows.

10           (2) Subclause (1) does not apply to an additional annual amount that is payable to a widow whose husband died as a result of a motor vehicle accident and who recovered damages in respect of his death.

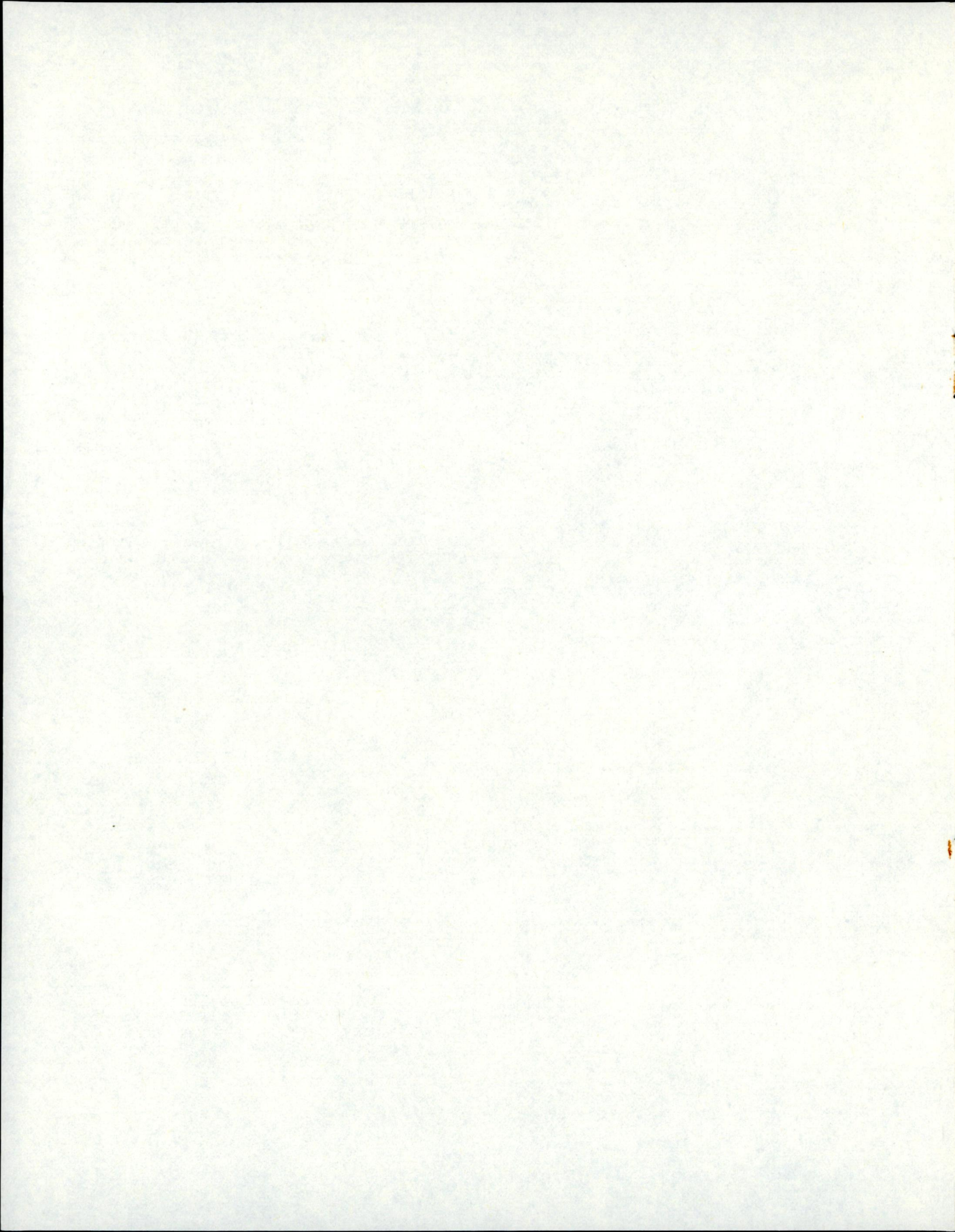

An Act to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, with respect to additional superannuation allowances payable to certain widows. [Assented to, 22nd October, 1980.]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Act, 1980".

**2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 28th September, 1979.

(1) The liability of the Fund in respect of any additional annual amount referred to in clause 2 may, if the widow to whom it is payable has so elected by notice in writing served on the Board before 1st April, 1980, be redeemed either in whole or in part by the payment from the Fund of a lump sum calculated on the basis of \$250 for each \$26 per annum of the additional annual amount that the widow elects to redeem.

(2) Subclause (1) does not apply to an additional annual amount that is payable to a widow whose husband died as a result of a motor vehicle accident and who recovered damages in respect of his death.
