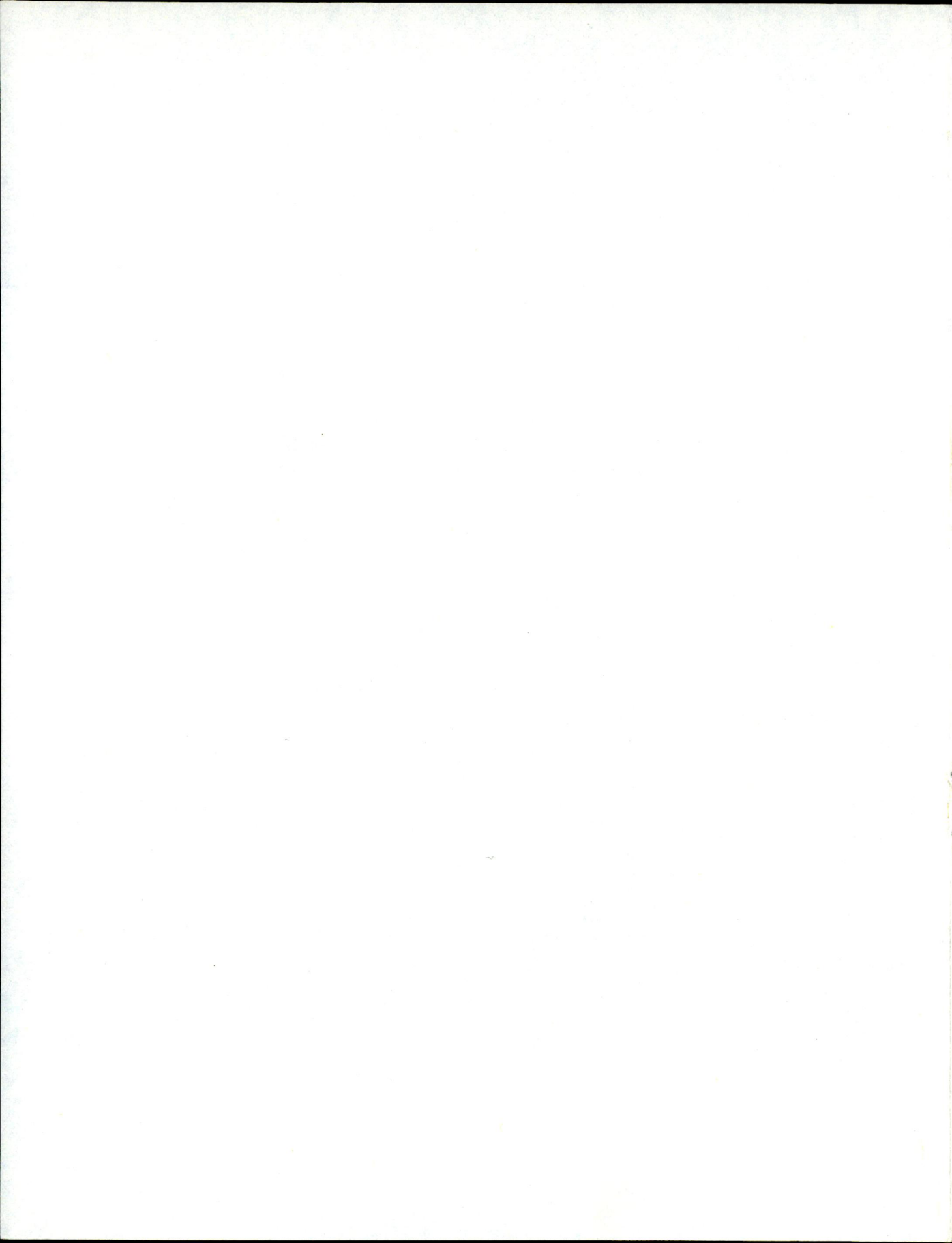

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
