BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Builders Licensing Board) Amendment Act, 1979”. Short title.
- 2.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.
- 10 (2) Section 3 shall commence on the day on which Schedule 1 to the Builders Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1979, commences.
