An Act to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequentially upon the constitution of the Corrective Services Commission of New South Wales. [Assented to, 29th December, 1978.]

Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Corrective Services) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Corrective Services) Amendment Act, 1978".

Commencement.

- **2.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence upon the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Section 3 shall commence upon the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Prisons (Amendment) Act, 1978.

3. The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is amended by inserting at the end of Part 1 of Schedule 2 the words "Chairman, Deputy Chairman and other the person appointed as a full-time Commissioner under the Prisons Act, 1952.".
