# Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Ethnic Affairs) Amendment.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Ethnic Affairs) Amendment Act, 1979".

Commencement.

- **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Ethnic Affairs Commission Act, 1979.

Amendment of Act No. 4, 1976. Schedule 3. 3. The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is amended by inserting at the end of Part 1 of Schedule 3 the following matter:—

Commissioner of the Ethnic Affairs Commission of New South Wales, other than the Chairman. The holder of the office if he is, pursuant to section 7 (2) (b) of the Ethnic Affairs Commission Act, 1979, appointed as a full-time commissioner.



#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)
