(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, so as to include in it provision for the determination of the salaries of the General Manager and Deputy General Manager of the Homebush Abattoir Corporation constituted under the Meat Industry Act, 1978.

The Commission has had the honor to receive from the Secretary of State a copy of the Bill as introduced into Parliament.
