EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Public Service Bill, 1979.

The object of this Bill is to effect amendments to the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequent on and in connection with the enactment of the proposed Public Service Act, 1979.

The Bill provides for the determination by the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Tribunal of the remuneration to be payable to Department Heads under the proposed Public Service Act, 1979.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

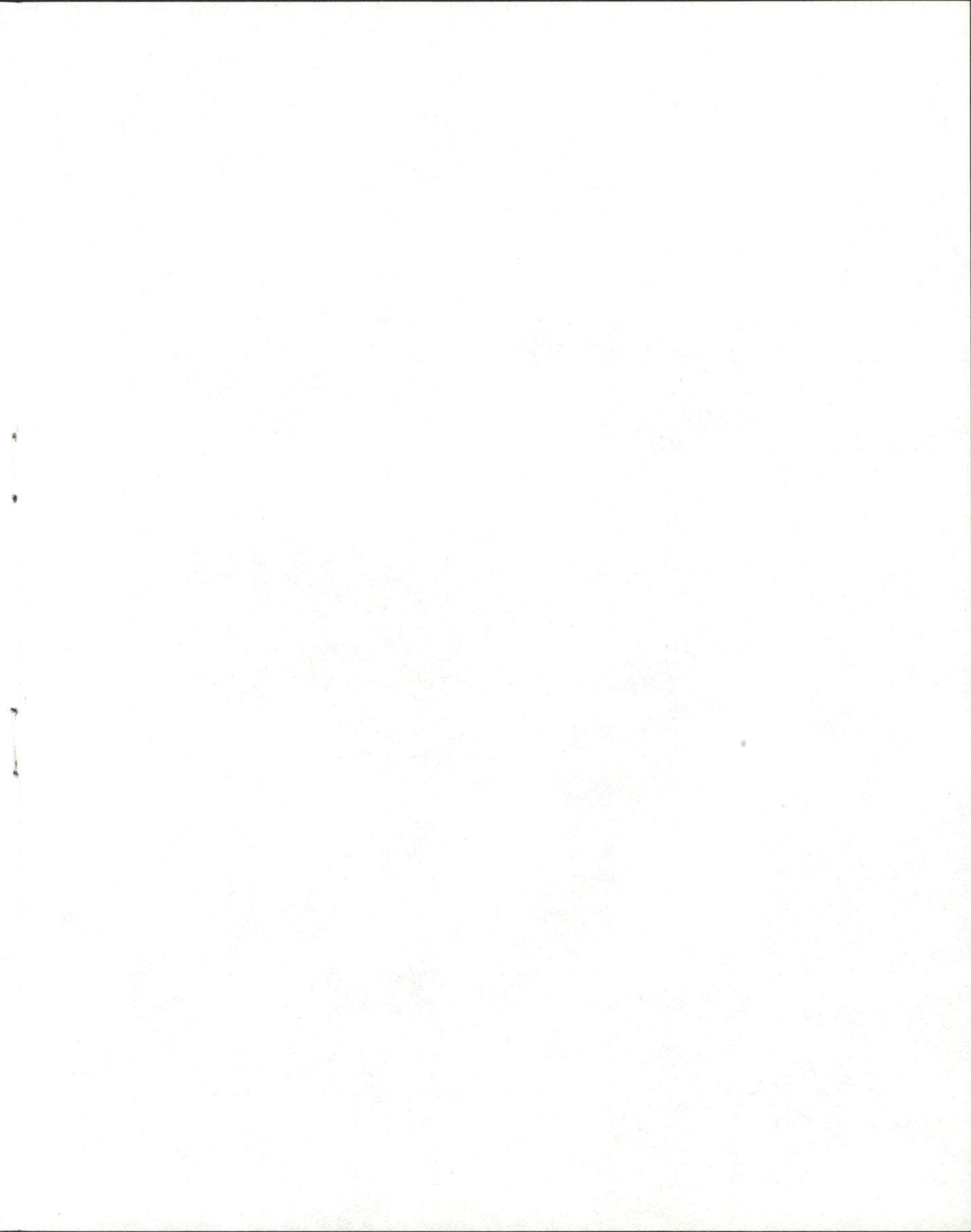
