**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Bill is to include in the Schedule of Public Offices in the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, the office of full-time elected member of the State Superannuation Board, and to make other provisions consequent on the enactment of the Superannuation (Amendment) Bill, 1978.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5    **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Statutory and Other Offices Short title.

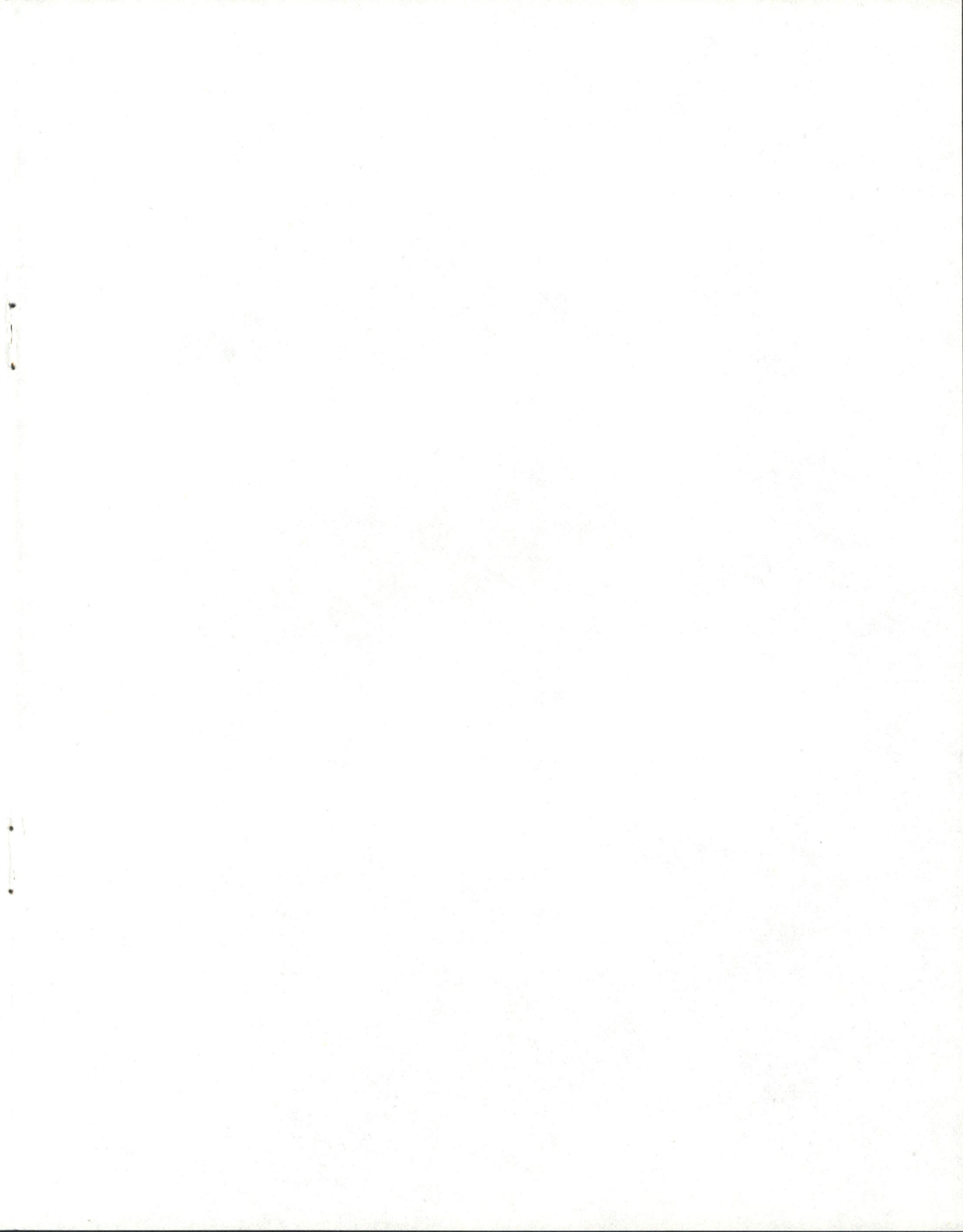

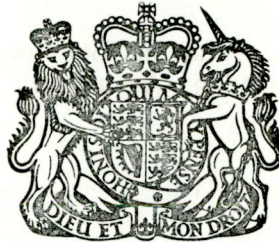

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Full-time member of the State Superannuation Board to whom section 70 (2) (a) (ii) of the Superannuation Act, 1916, applies.

Full-time elected member of the State Superannuation Board.
