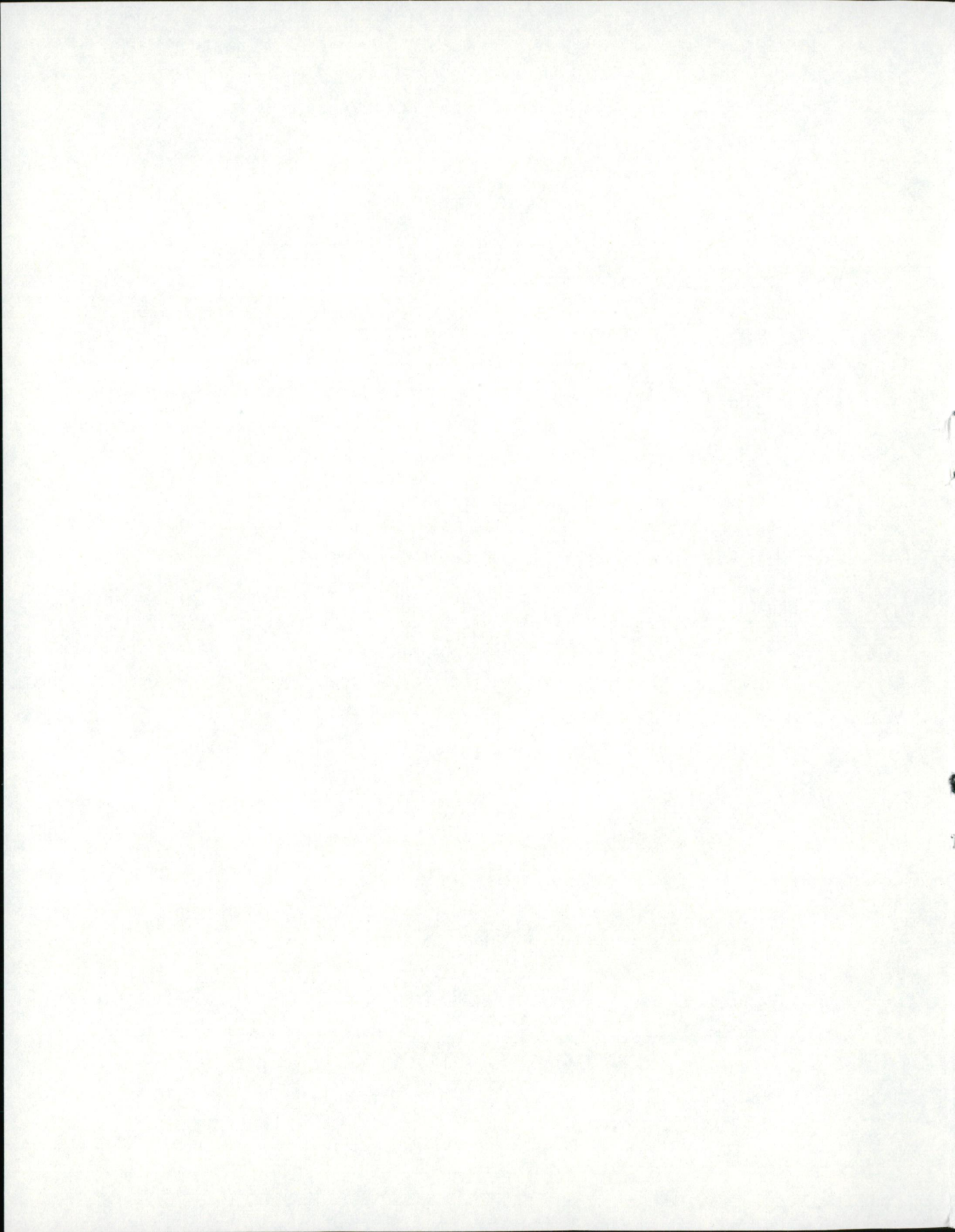
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Transport Authorities Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequent on the enactment of the proposed Transport Authorities Act, 1980.

The Bill removes the references to the Commissioners of the Public Transport Commission from the list of office holders contained in the Act, and adds references to the Chief Executive and Deputy Chief Executives of the State Rail Authority and the Managing Director of the Urban Transit Authority, to be appointed under the Transport Authorities Act, 1980, if enacted.

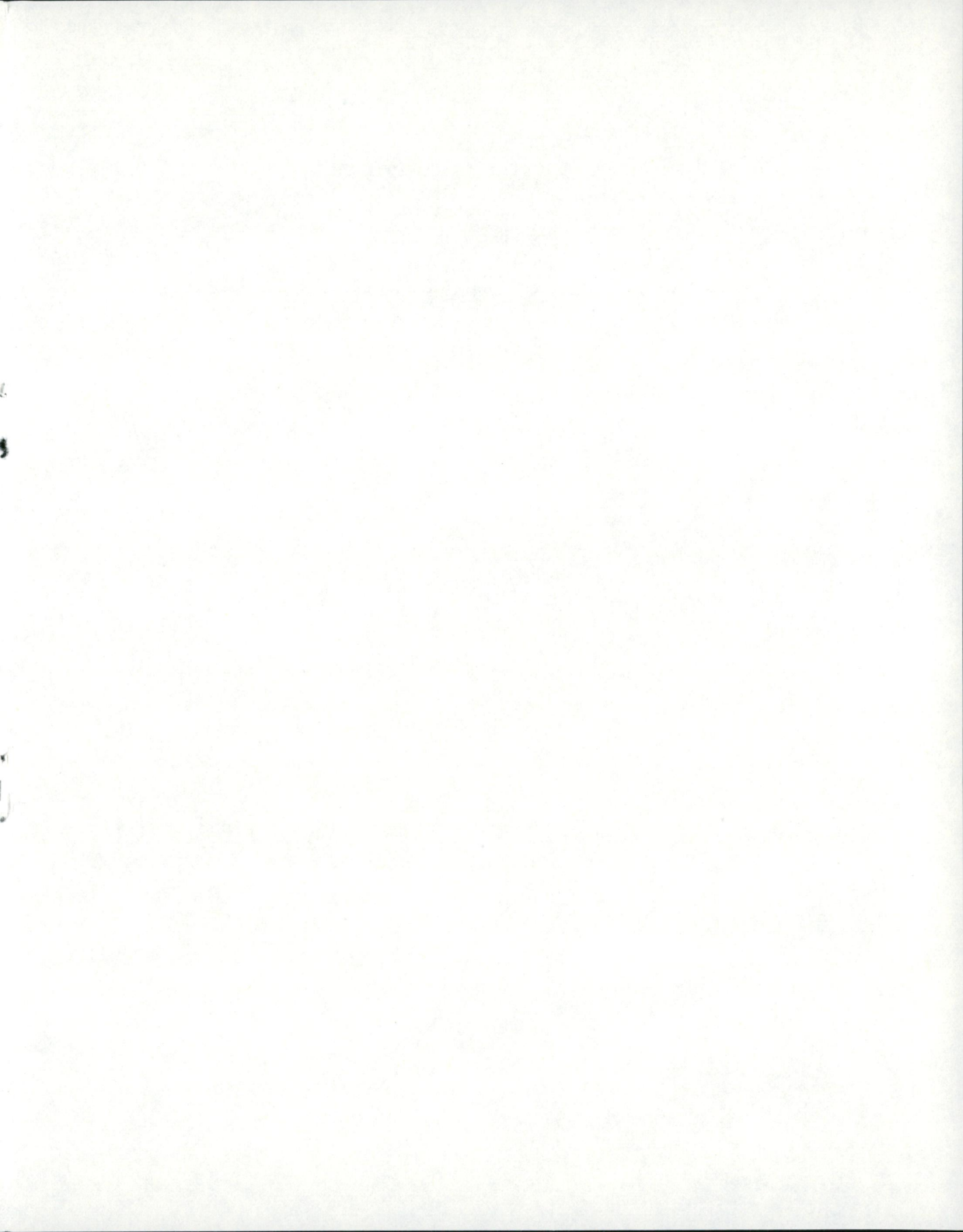

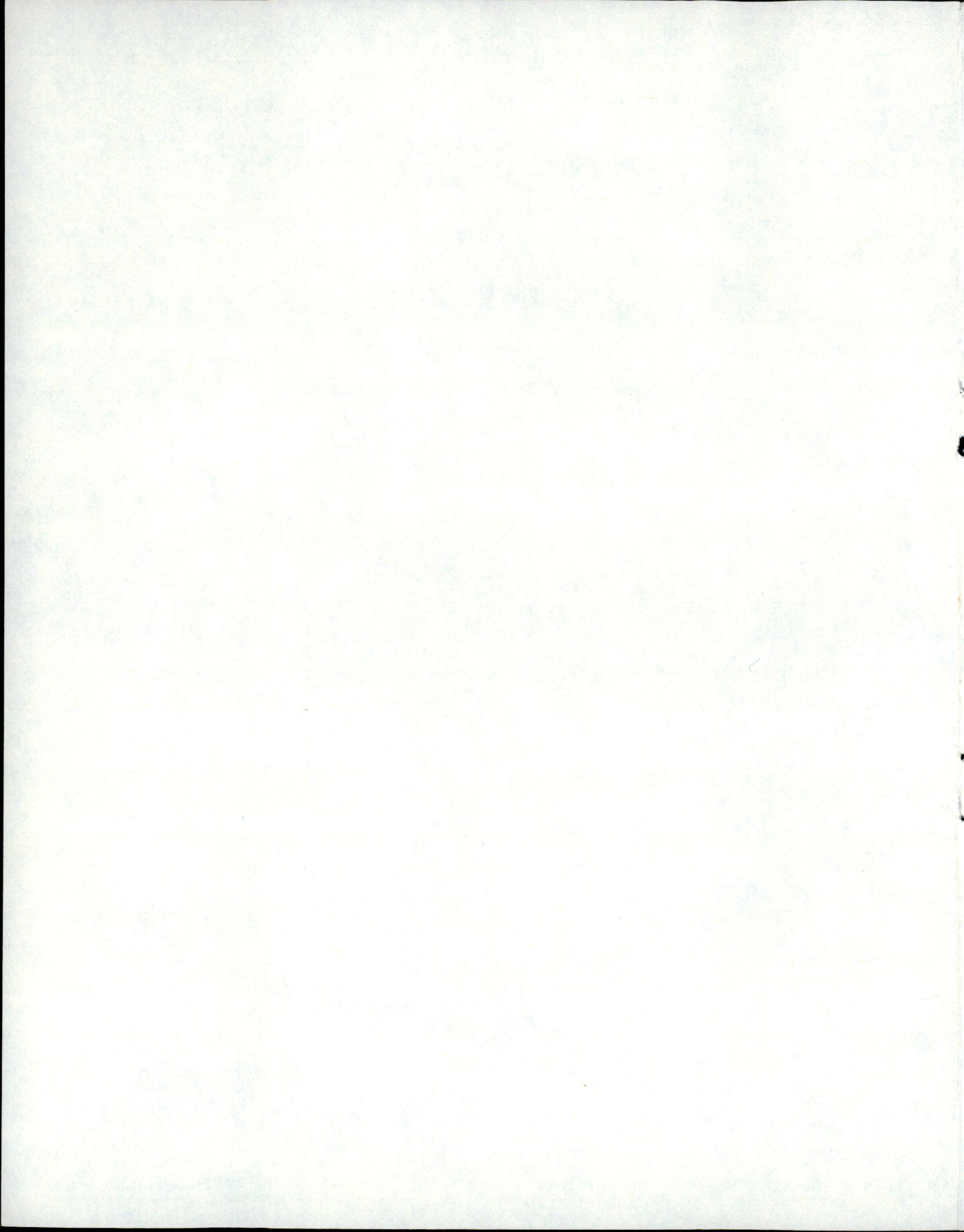

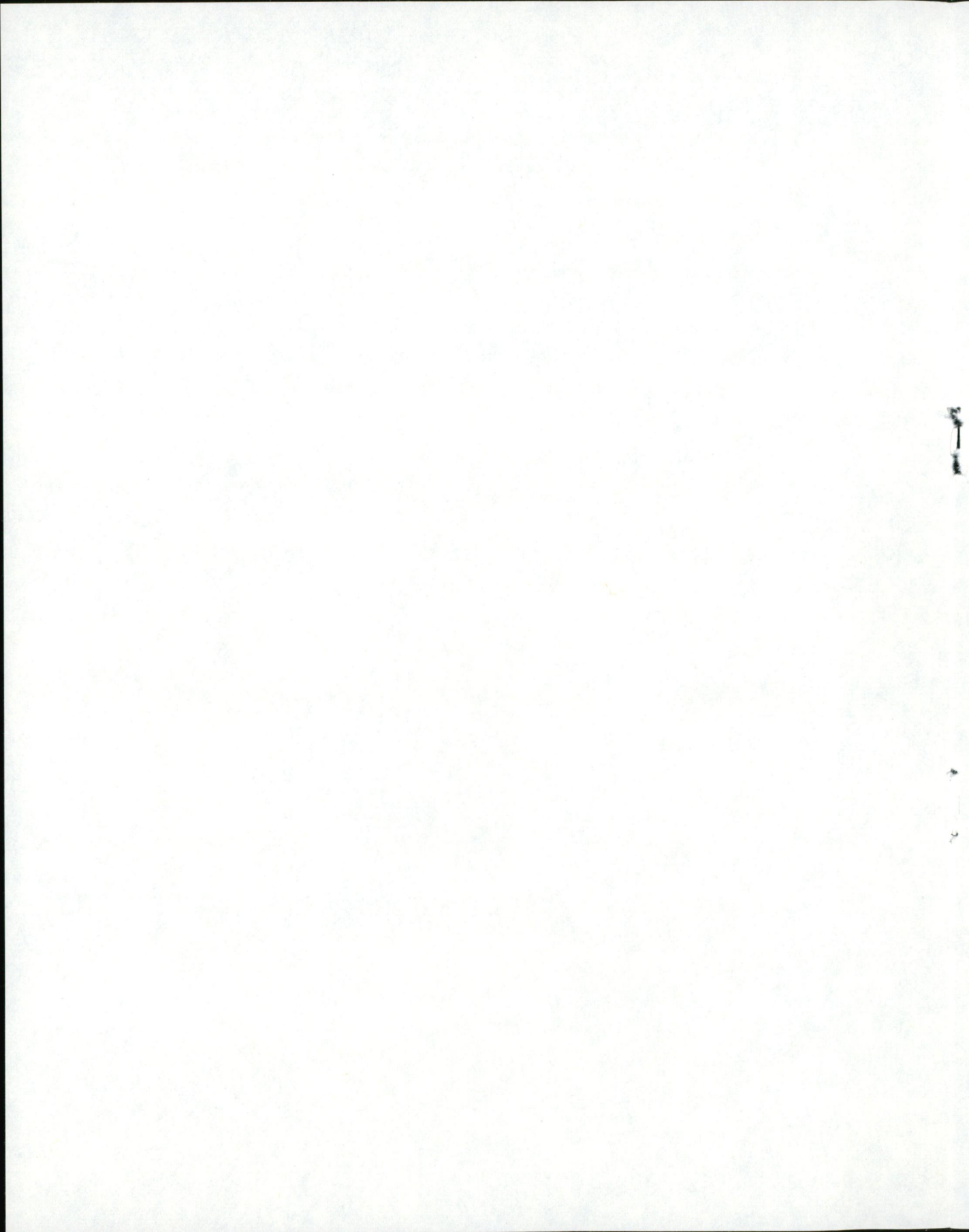
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Transport Authorities Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequent on the enactment of the proposed Transport Authorities Act, 1980.

The Bill removes the references to the Commissioners of the Public Transport Commission from the list of office holders contained in the Act, and adds references to the Chief Executive and Deputy Chief Executives of the State Rail Authority and the Managing Director of the Urban Transit Authority, to be appointed under the Transport Authorities Act, 1980, if enacted.

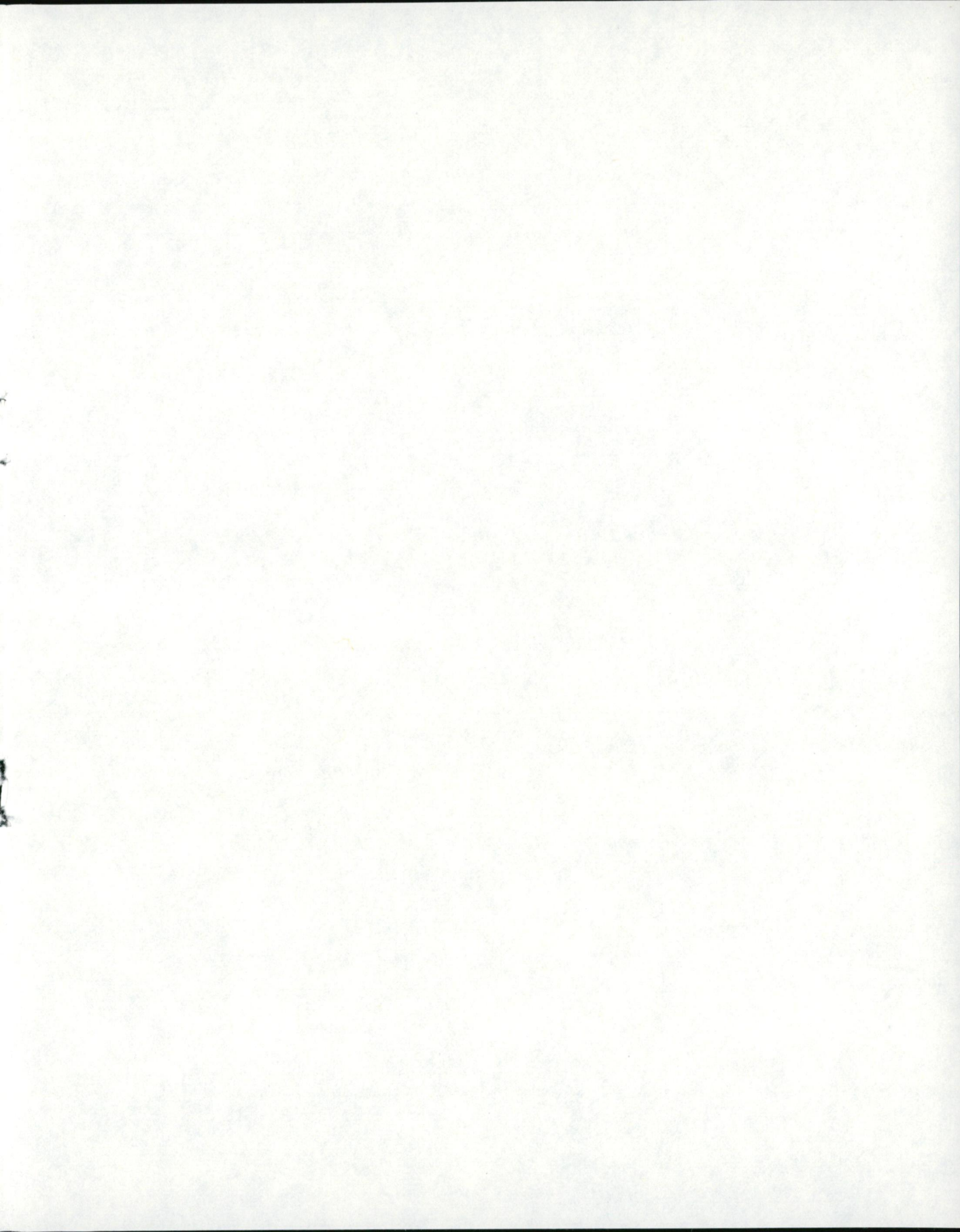
