EXPLANATORY NOTE

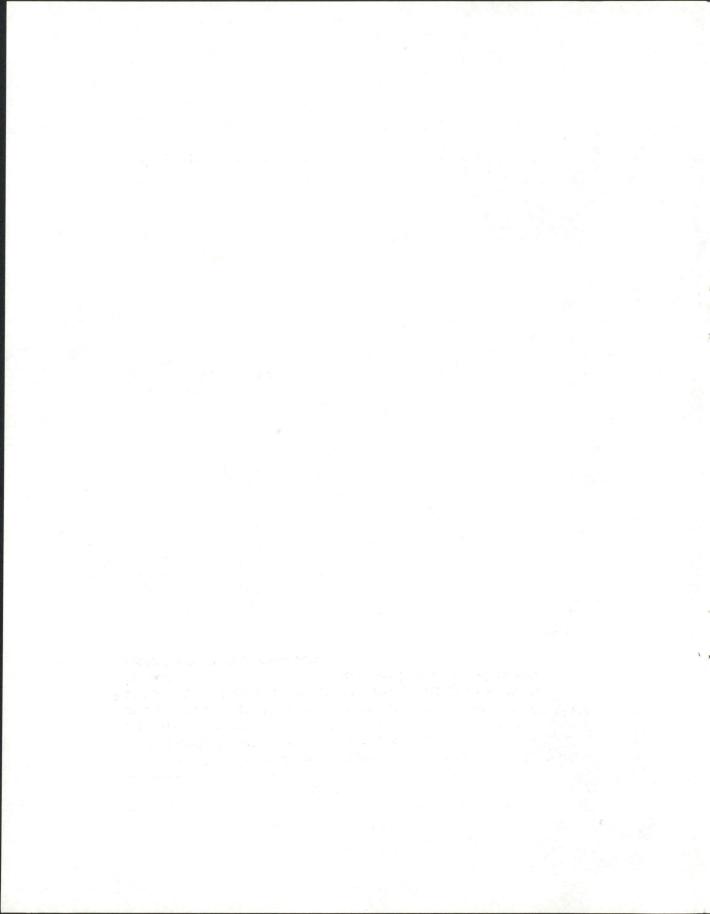
(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

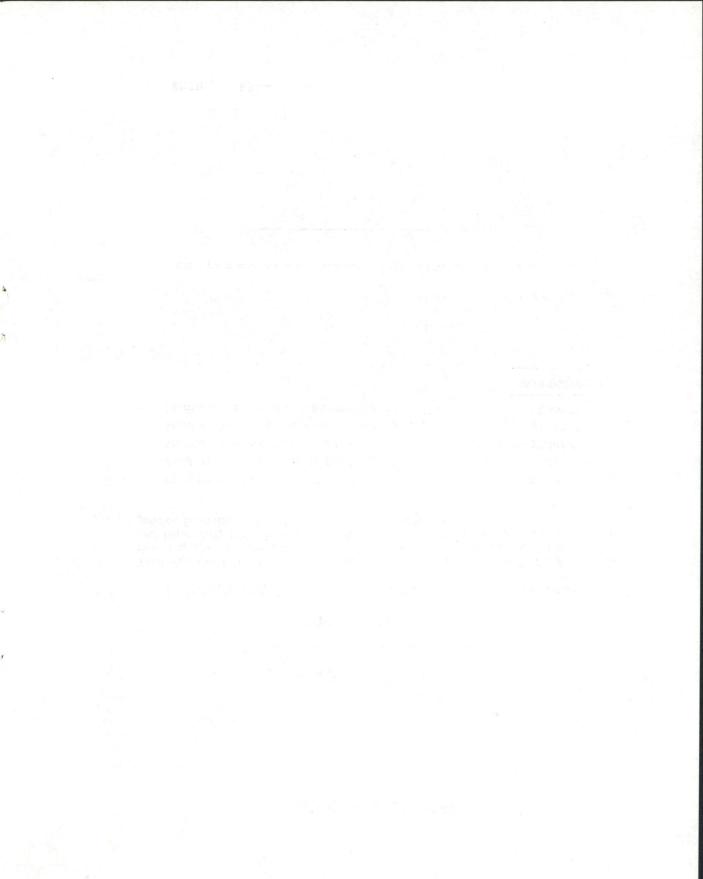

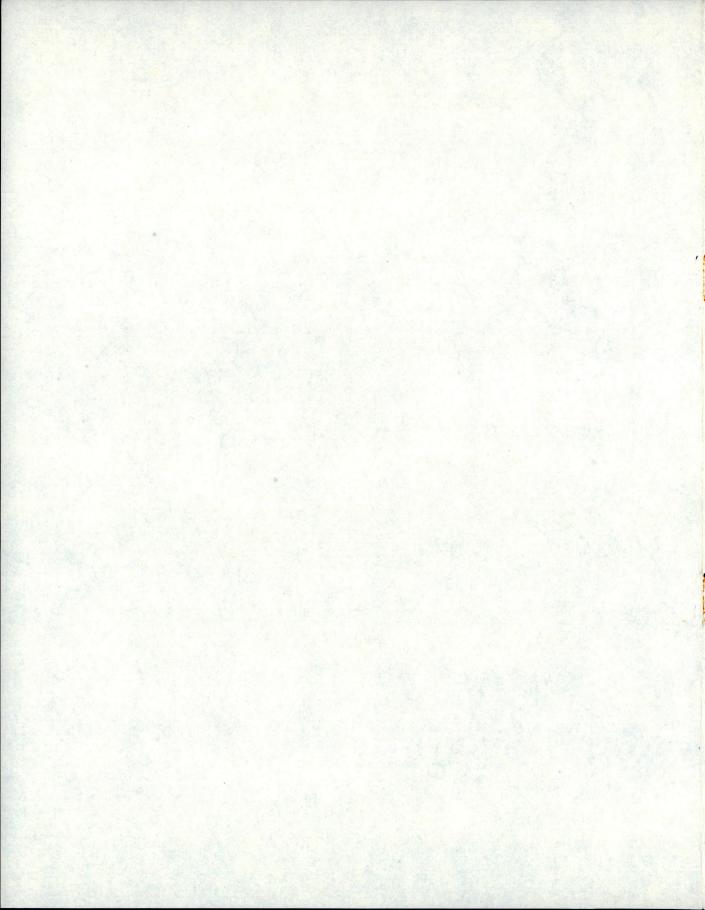

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1980".

\$593,421,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
