BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment Act, 1980". Short title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.
