This Bill is cognate with the Stock Diseases (Further Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1928, so as-

- (a) to provide that the Governor may revoke or amend any proclamation made by him declaring a disease of pigs to be a disease to which that Act applies; and
- (b) to make it clear that an approval given to a person to enable that person, in certain circumstances, to order the destruction of a pig may be revoked.

Swine Compensation (Amendment)

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation (Amendment) Act, 1980".
