EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Bill is to amend the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Act, 1978, by way of statute law revision, so as—

- (a) to ensure that the first elected members of the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust hold office for the balance of the 4 year period following the constitution of the Trust by that Act; and
- (b) to omit a reference to the Public Service Act, 1902, and insert instead a reference to the Public Service Act, 1979.

An Act to amend the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Act, 1978, with respect to the term of office of certain members of the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground (Amendment) Act, 1981".




