

SYDNEY HARBOUR TRUST (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1979

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Real Property (Computer Register) Amendment Bill, 1979.

The object of this Bill is to provide that, where an application has been made to bring under the provisions of the Real Property Act, 1900, certain resumed land vested in the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, a proclamation may not be published in the Gazette under the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900, withdrawing that land from that Board, so that any proclamation so published under the latter Act may not have the effect of preventing that land from being brought under those provisions pursuant to that application.
