Teaching Service (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Teaching Service (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commence-ment. **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980.
