

**THEATRES AND PUBLIC HALLS (PROFESSIONAL BOXING
CONTROL) AMENDMENT BILL, 1980**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Professional Boxing Control Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 27 of the Theatres and Public Halls Act, 1908, to remove boxing contests within the meaning of the proposed Professional Boxing Control Act, 1980, from the operation of that section.

THEATRE AND FILM ROLLS PROFESSIONAL BOARD

GENERAL NOTE

The provisions of this Act apply to all persons who are engaged in the business of producing, distributing, exhibiting or otherwise dealing with films or film-records, or who are engaged in the business of producing, distributing, exhibiting or otherwise dealing with television programmes or television records, or who are engaged in the business of producing, distributing, exhibiting or otherwise dealing with sound recordings or records, or who are engaged in the business of producing, distributing, exhibiting or otherwise dealing with gramophone records or records.
