

TRANSPORT (FURTHER AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to increase, from \$20 to \$200, the penalty which may be imposed for certain offences relating to transport services.

TRANSPORT (FURTHER AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill is cognate with the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Bill, 1979. It is proposed to introduce into Parliament this Bill in cognate with the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Bill, 1979. The object of the Bill is to increase from ₹10 to ₹500, the penalty which may be imposed for certain offences relating to transport services.
