

TRANSPORT AUTHORITIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to increase, from \$100 to \$200, the penalty which may be imposed for a contravention of a regulation made under the Transport Authorities Act, 1980.

The Bill also amends the Transport Authorities Act, 1980, by way of statute law revision.

TRANSPORT ACT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Government have pleasure in presenting this Bill to the House of Commons. The Bill is a consequence of the Government's Transport Policy Statement of 1979. The object of the Bill is to increase from 2500 to 3500 the number of vehicles which are exempt from the requirement of a registration mark under the Transport Act, 1980. The Bill also amends the provisions of the Transport Act, 1980 which relate to the registration of motor vehicles.

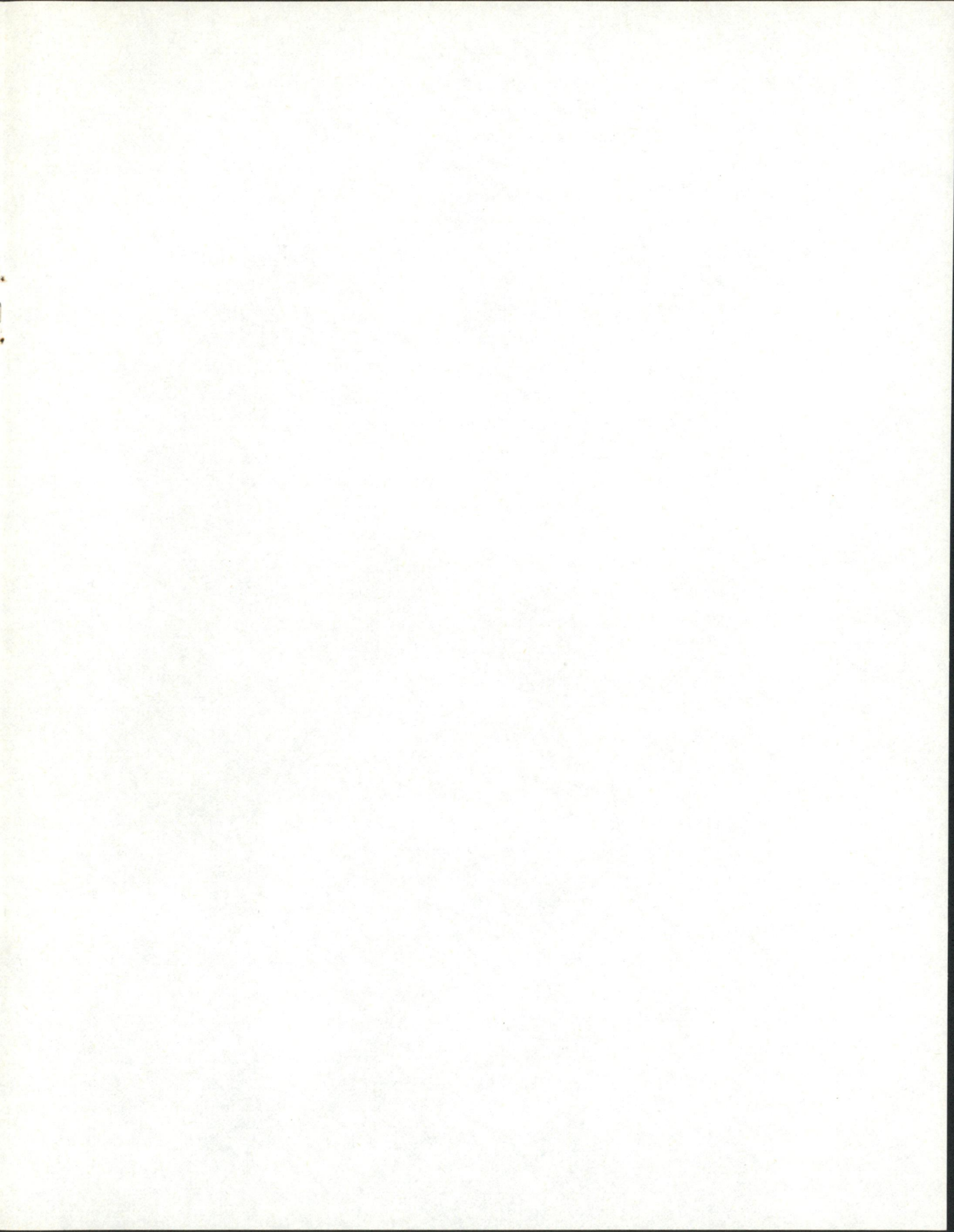

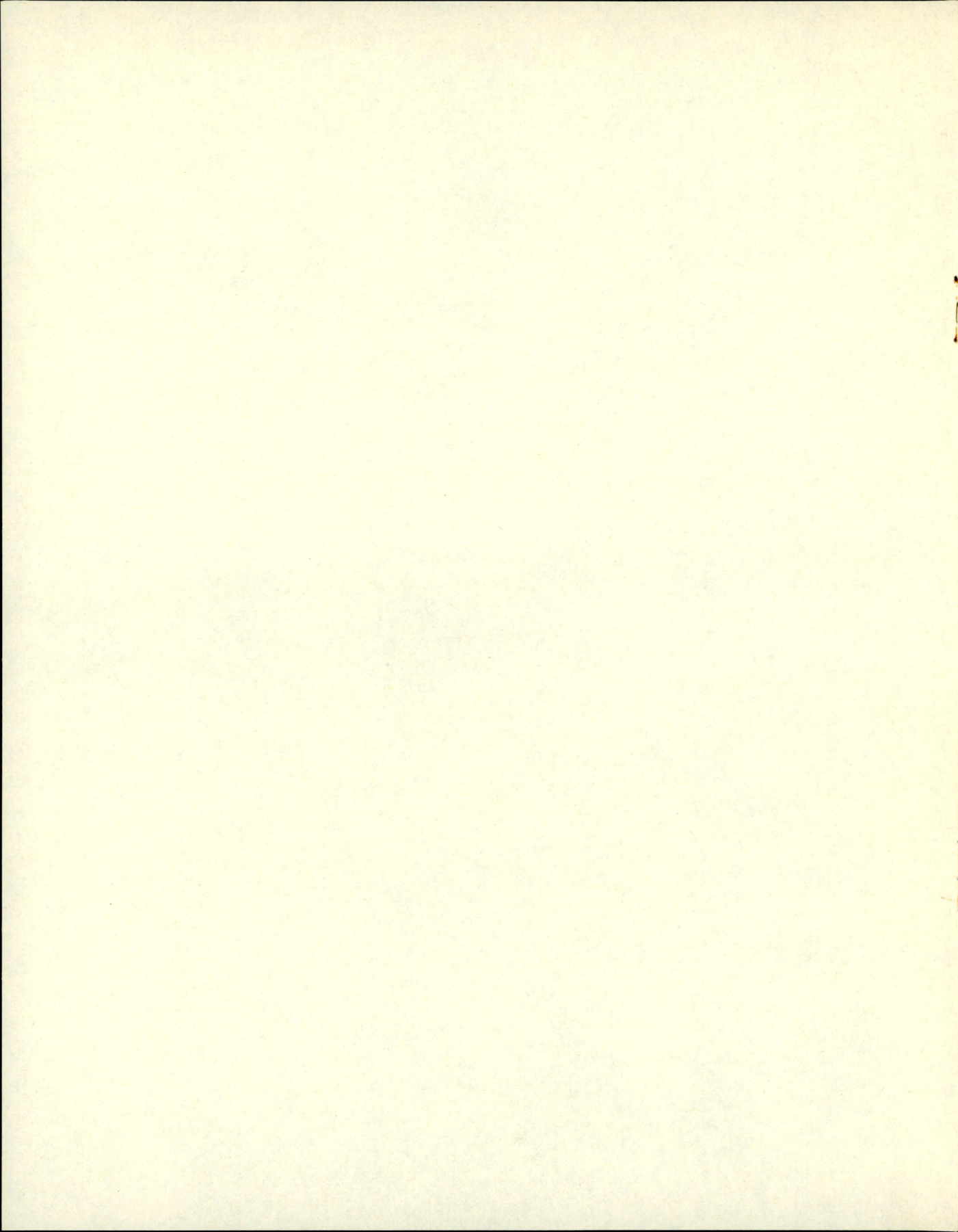

Act No. 140, 1980.

An Act to amend the Transport Authorities Act, 1980, to increase the penalty for a contravention of a regulation made under that Act and by way of statute law revision. [Assented to, 9th December, 1980.]

Transport Authorities (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short
title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Transport Authorities (Amendment) Act, 1980".

Commence-
ment.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Act, 1980.
