

**UNIVERSITY OF NEWCASTLE (AMENDMENT) BILL,

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The following Bills are cognate with this Bill:—

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to amend section 10 of the University of Newcastle Act, 1964 (“the Principal Act”)—
 - (i) to decrease the number of persons who may be appointed to the Council of the University of Newcastle (“the University”) by the Minister from 6 to 5 (Schedule 1 (1));
 - (ii) to increase the number of members (other than professors) of the academic staff of the University who may be elected to the Council of the University (“the Council”) by members of the academic staff from 1 to 2 (Schedule 1 (2) (a));
 - (iii) to increase the number of persons who may be elected to the Council by members of the staff other than the academic staff of the University from 1 to 2 (Schedule 1 (2) (b));
 - (iv) to increase the number of persons who may be appointed or elected to the Council by Convocation from 5 to 6 (Schedule 1 (3));
 - (v) to decrease the number of persons who may be appointed or elected to the Council by the members of the Council from 4 to 3 (Schedule 1 (4)); and
 - (vi) to provide that the person holding office as Deputy Chairman of the Senate of the University shall, where that person is not a member of the Council by virtue of another provision of section 10, be ex officio a member of the Council (Schedule 1 (5));

(b) to amend the Principal Act by way of statute law revision (Schedule 2);
and

(c) to make other provisions of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—
