EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Workers' Compensation (Brucellosis) Bill, 1979.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 7 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1926, to provide that, if the result of a medical test carried out for the purpose of determining whether a person has a zoonotic disease (brucellosis, Q fever or leptospirosis) is the same result as a result prescribed by regulation in respect of that disease, that person shall be deemed, for the purposes of that Act, to have contracted that disease.

Workers' Compensation (Brucellosis) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Workers' Compensation (Brucellosis) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

2. The Workers' Compensation Act, 1926, is amended by inserting after section 7 (4D) the following subsection :— Amendment of Act No. 15, 1926.

10 (4E) For the purposes of this Act, the disease brucellosis, Sec. 7.
Q fever or leptospirosis shall be deemed to have been contracted by a worker if the result of any medical test— (Liability of employers to workers for injuries.)

(a) which complies with such requirements as are prescribed in relation to that disease; and

15 (b) which was carried out for the purpose of determining whether that worker has contracted that disease,

is a result prescribed in respect of that disease.

WORKERS COMPENSATION (BROCK) BILL, 1979

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill is designed to amend section 7 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1971, to provide that in the event of a medical test carried out for the purpose of determining whether a person has a condition covered by section 7, the test shall be carried out at the expense of the person concerned, and that the results of the test shall be available to the person concerned.
